






2. Distribution of Editorial Board Members

% of total: 100% (315 Board Members from 24 countries)














3. Distribution of Corresponding Authors in 2020










4. Total Citations of JTD on WOS(2017-2020)










5. Journal Impact Factor










6. Proportion of Diverse Types of Articles Published in 2020










9. Monthly Retrievals in PubMed (2012-2020)


