



6. Geographic Distribution of Editorial Board Members




AOL has a editorial board team of **35** members from **11** countries, with the majority from the USA. They are the leading experts in the field of lymphoma research.

7. Diverse Types of Articles Published in 2021




AOL published **34** articles in 2021. The major article types published in AOL include Review Article, Editorial and Case Report.

8. International Diversity of Corresponding Authors in 2021




In total, **37** Corresponding Authors from **11** countries contributed to AOL in 2021, with the majority from **USA, UK and Italy**.
