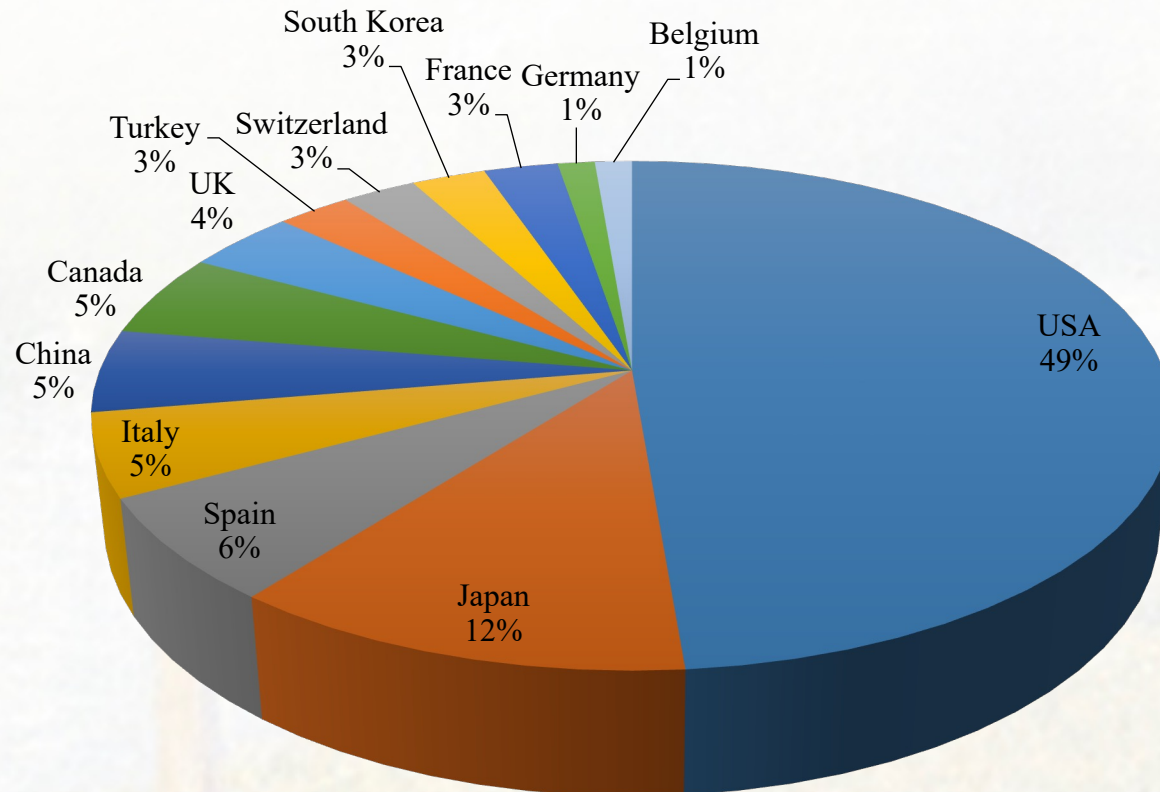

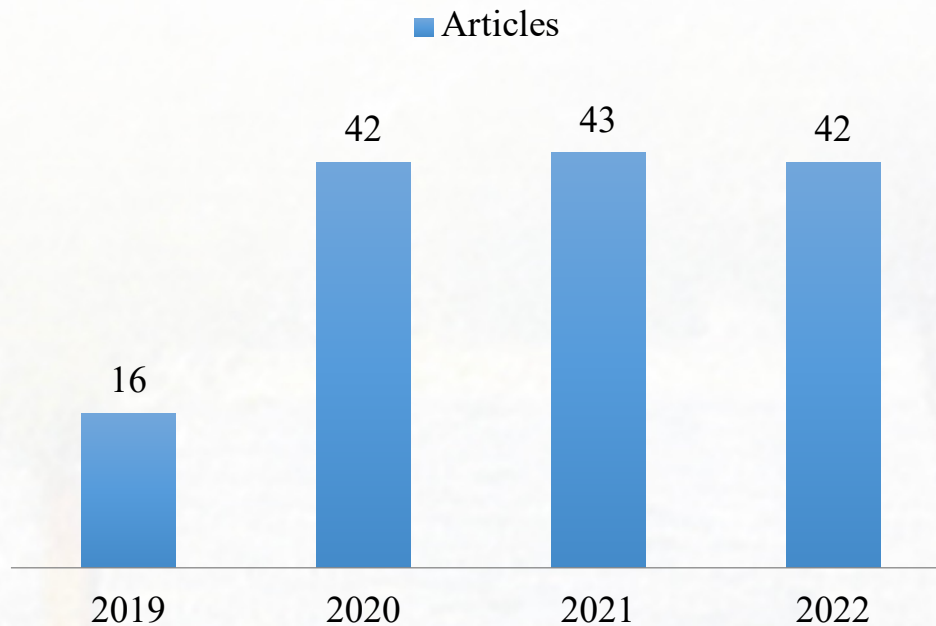
2. Geographic Distribution of Editorial Board Members (2022)

% of total: 100% (76 Members from 13 countries)



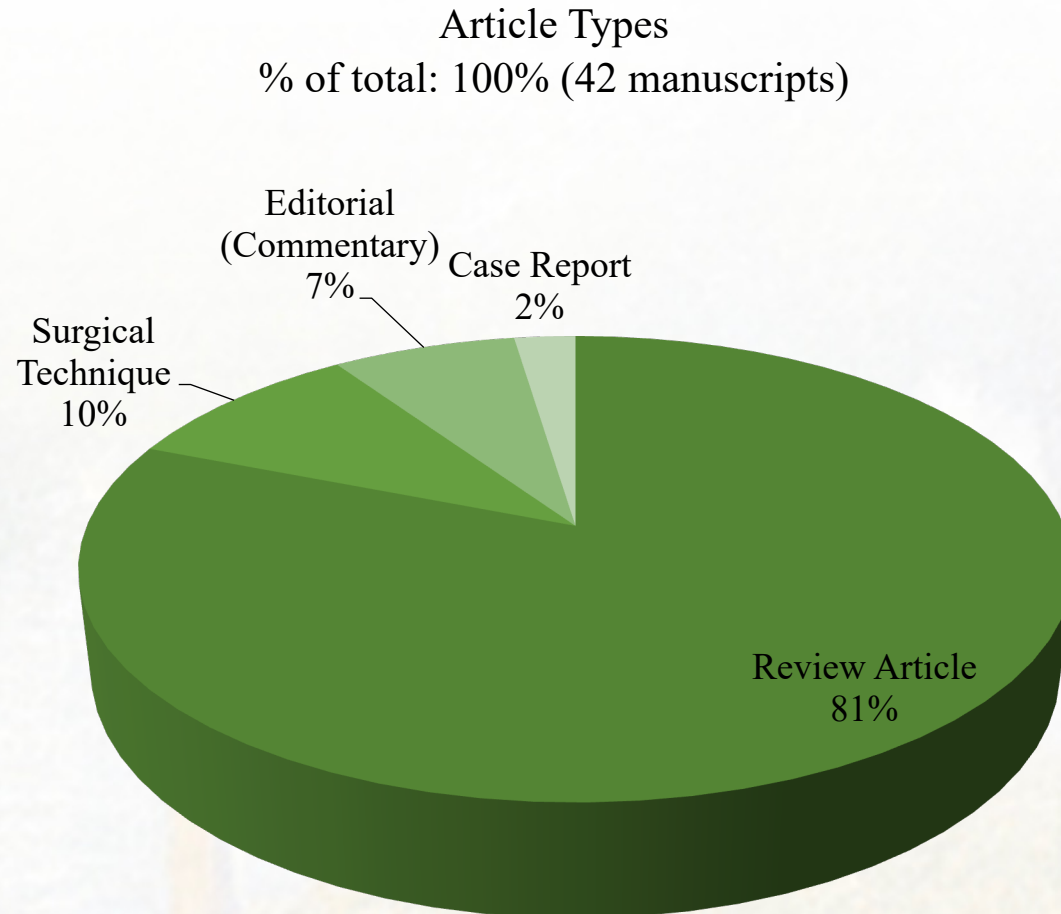
CCTS has built an internationalized editorial board of 76 members, with a major from USA (49%), followed by Japan (12%), Spain (6%), Italy (5%), etc.

The articles published in CCTS have remained stable, with a total number of 143 since its launch in 2019.

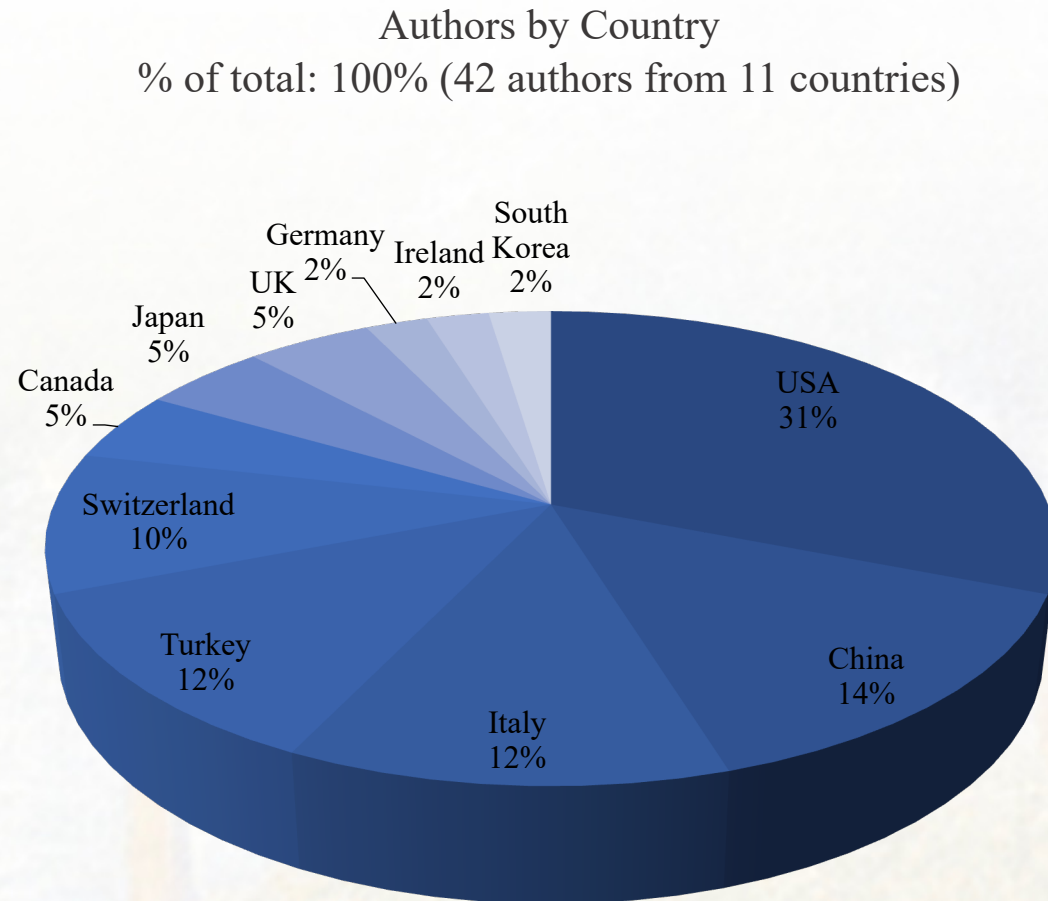
4. Different Types of Articles Published in 2022



A total of 42 articles were published in 2022, including:

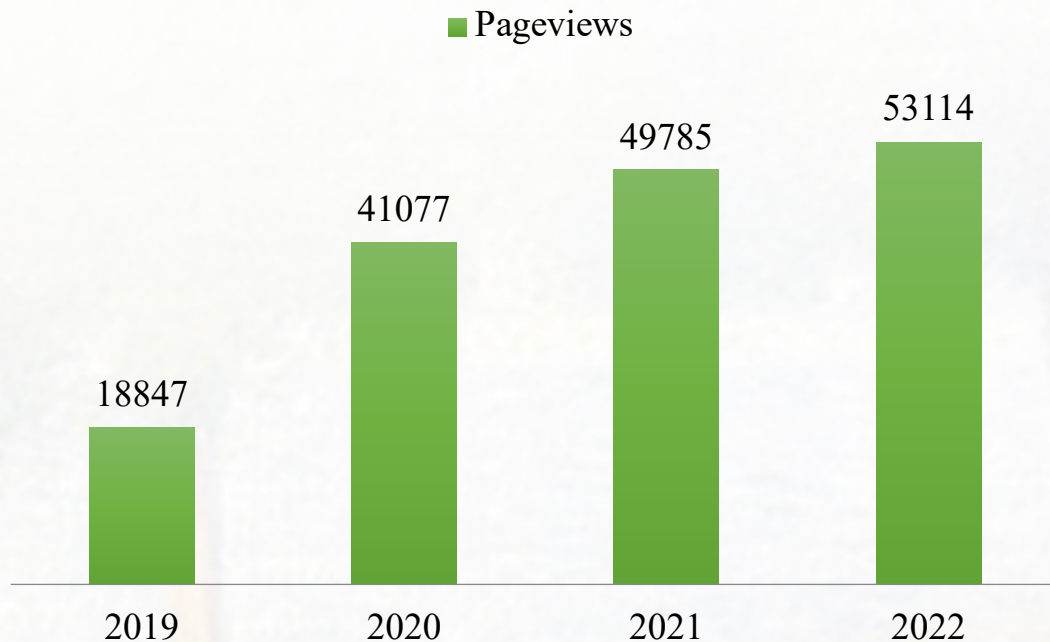

6. Website Pageviews (Results by Year, 2019 - 2022)

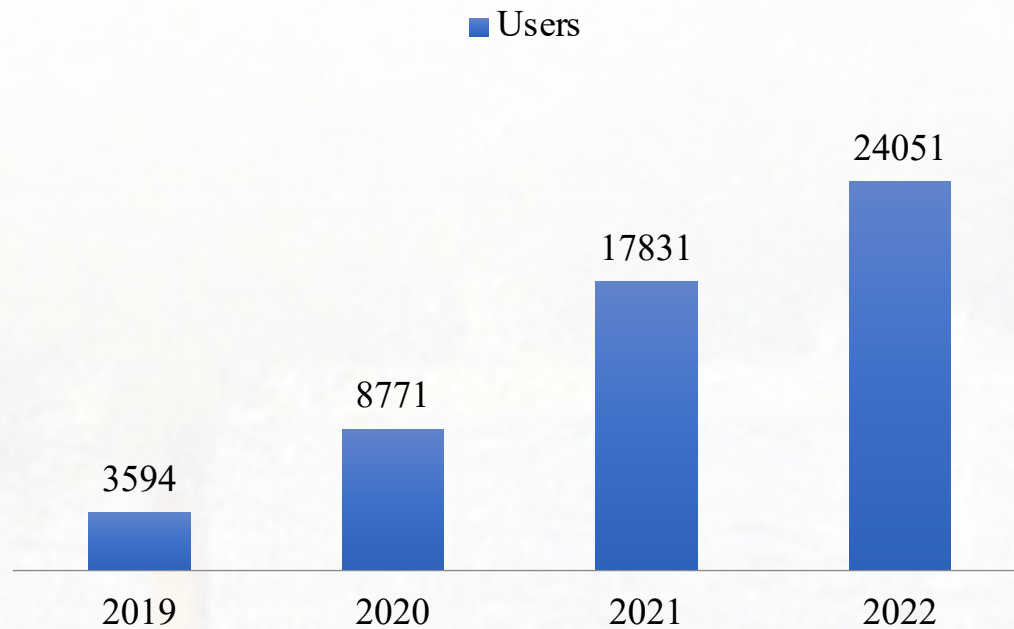


* Website pageviews of CCTS have continued to grow since its launch in 2019.

7. Website Users (Results by Year, 2019 – 2022)














* Website users of CCTS have significantly increased since its launch in 2019.
