

- Focus on current challenges, controversial issues and unresolved situations related to surgery for pulmonary, tracheal, mediastinal, esophageal, and chest-wall diseases



CCTS has built an internationalized editorial board of 76 members, with a major from USA (49%), followed by Japan (12%), Spain (6%), Italy (5%), etc.



The articles published in CCTS have remained stable, with a total number of 143 since its launch in 2019.







A total of 42 corresponding authors from 11 countries were identified in 2022, with the largest percentage of authors from USA (31%).






