

2. Distribution of Editorial Board Members




Till the end of 2023, there are 52 Members from 9 countries on board, including:


3. Diverse Types of Articles Published in 2023

Corresponding authors of the **25** articles published in 2023 come from **8** countries with **68%** of them from the USA.






