



#### 4. Distribution of Editorial Board Members




### 5. Publication: Number(results by year)



Note: JGO is published quarterly from 2010 to 2013 and has been a bi-monthly journal since 2014.




### 5. Publication: Article Type



In 2020, JGO has published 141 articles, among which there are 94 original articles and 28 review articles.




### 5. Publication: Internationality

### 6. Monthly Retrievals in PubMed


