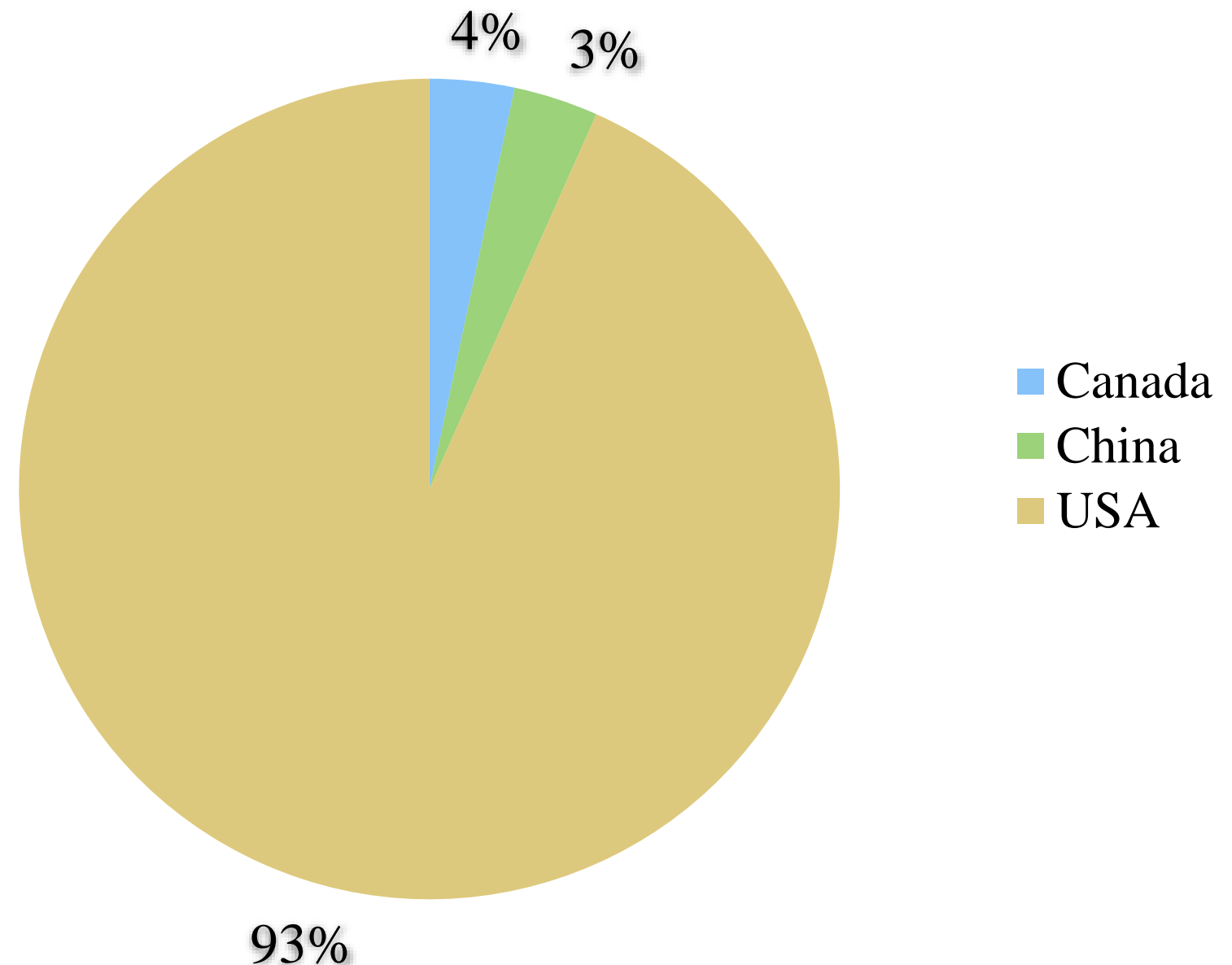

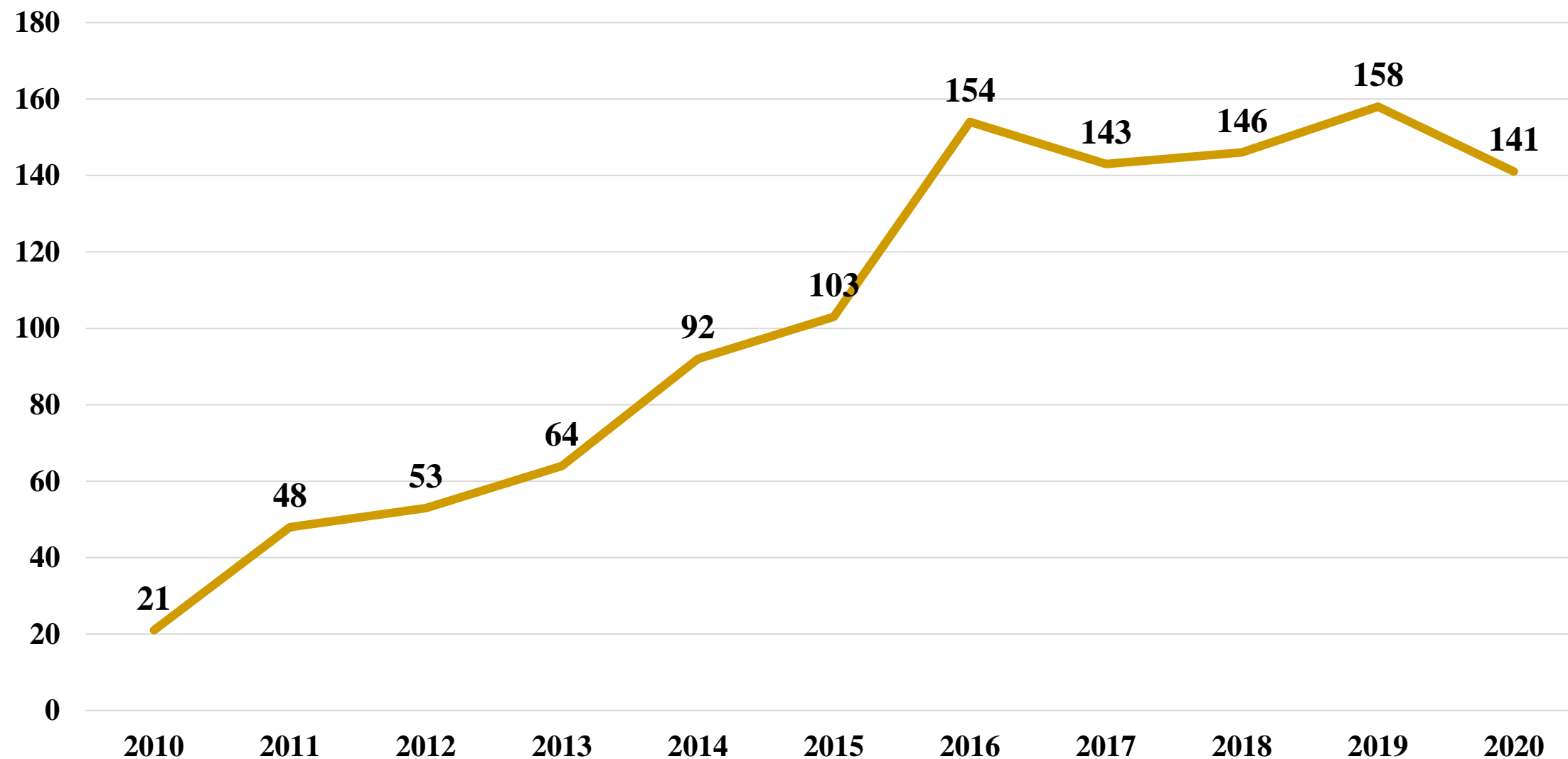
4. Distribution of Editorial Board Members

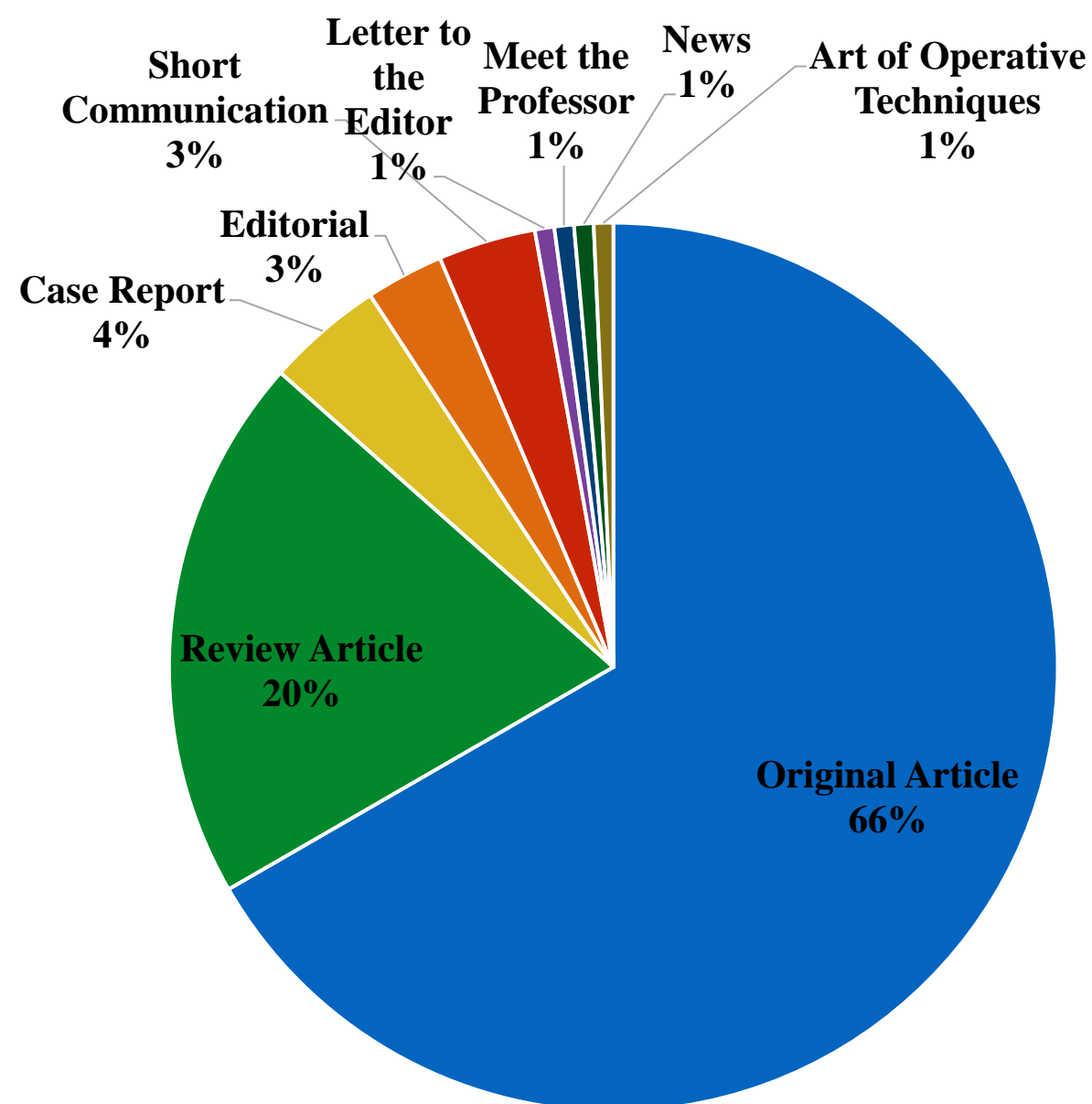


5. Publication: Number(results by year)



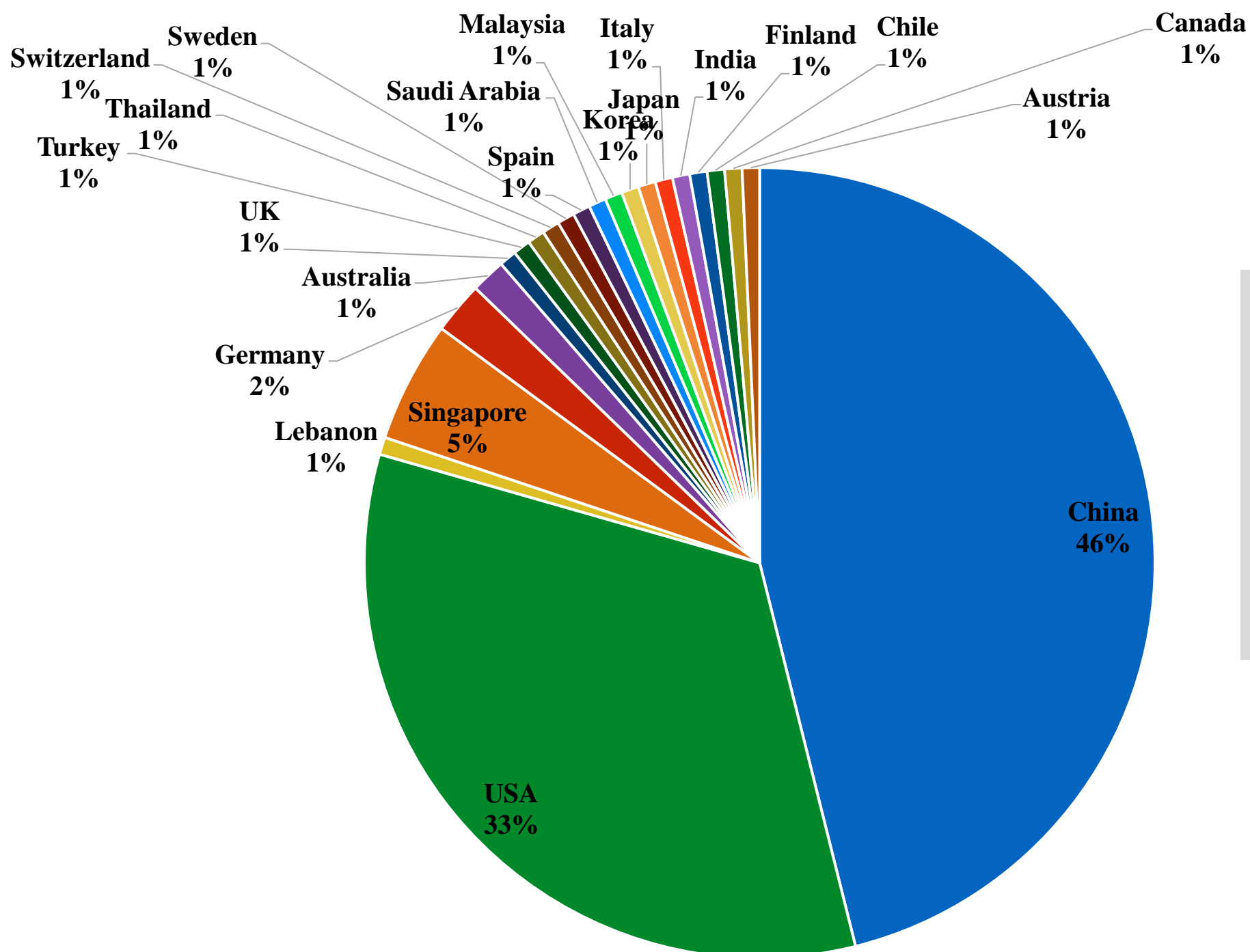
Note: JGO is published quarterly from 2010 to 2013 and has been a bi-monthly journal since 2014.

Corresponding authors of 141 articles in 2020 come from 22 different countries, with 46% of them from China and 33% of them from USA.

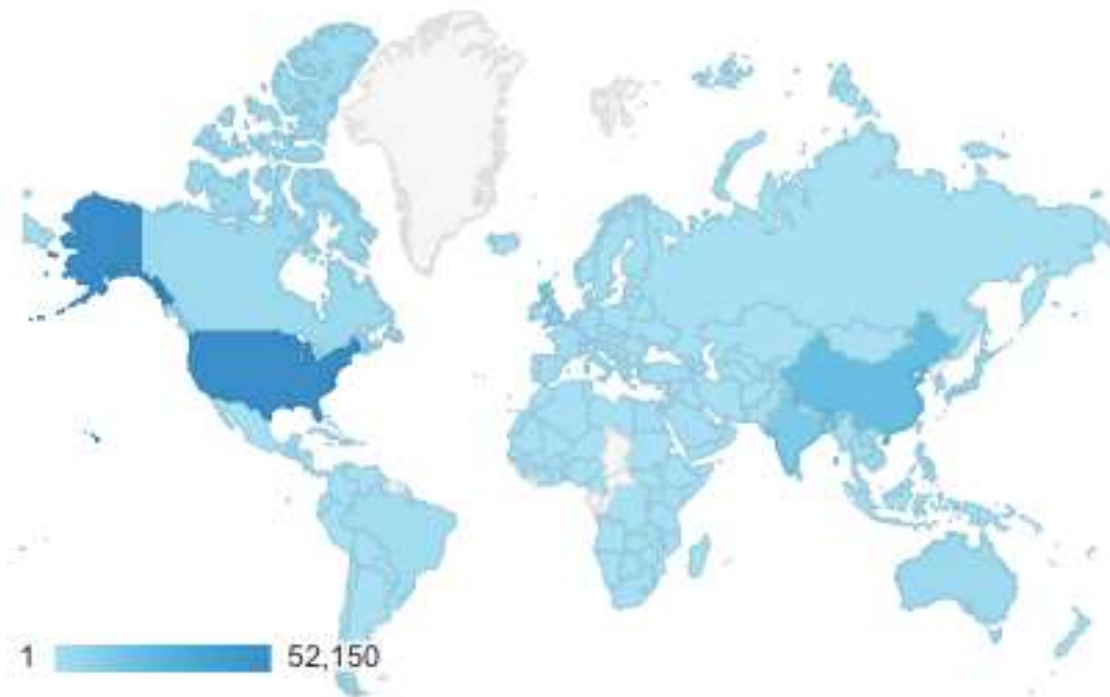
6. Monthly Retrievals in PubMed
