




3. Geographical Distribution of Editorial Board Members

4. Number of Published Articles (results by year)



5. Types of Article Published in 2022


In 2022, CCO has published a total of **51 manuscripts**, including **32 Review** Articles and **4 Original** Articles in total.






6. International Diversity of Corresponding Authors in 2022






