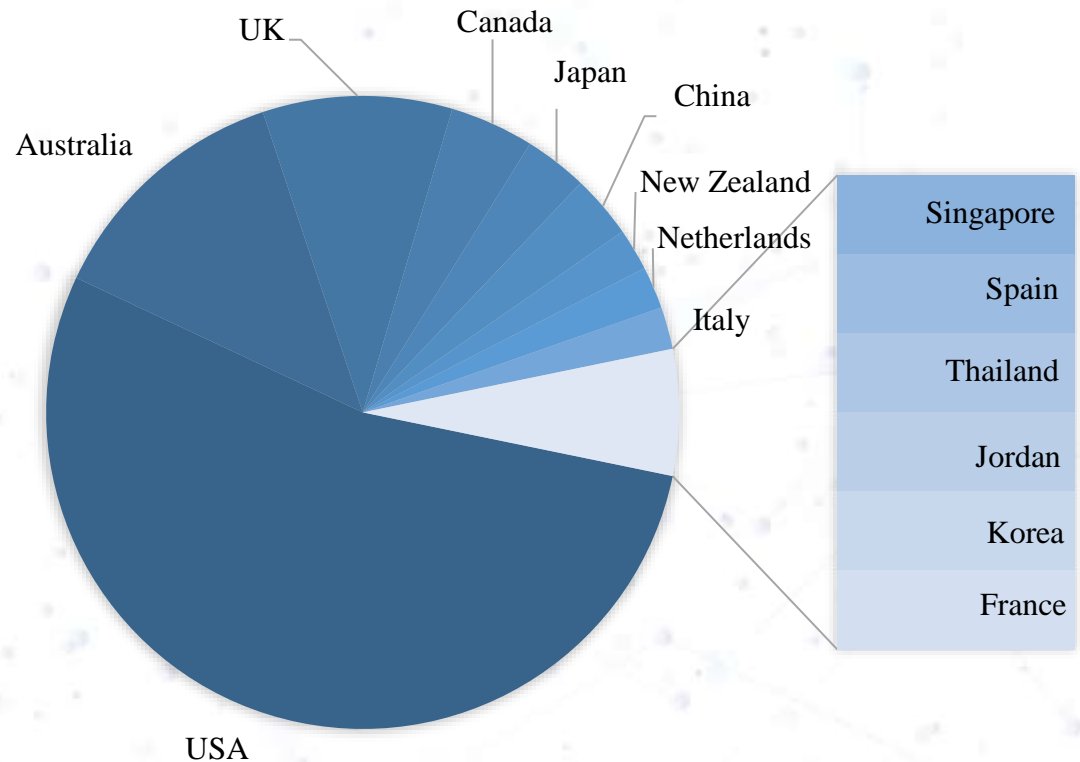

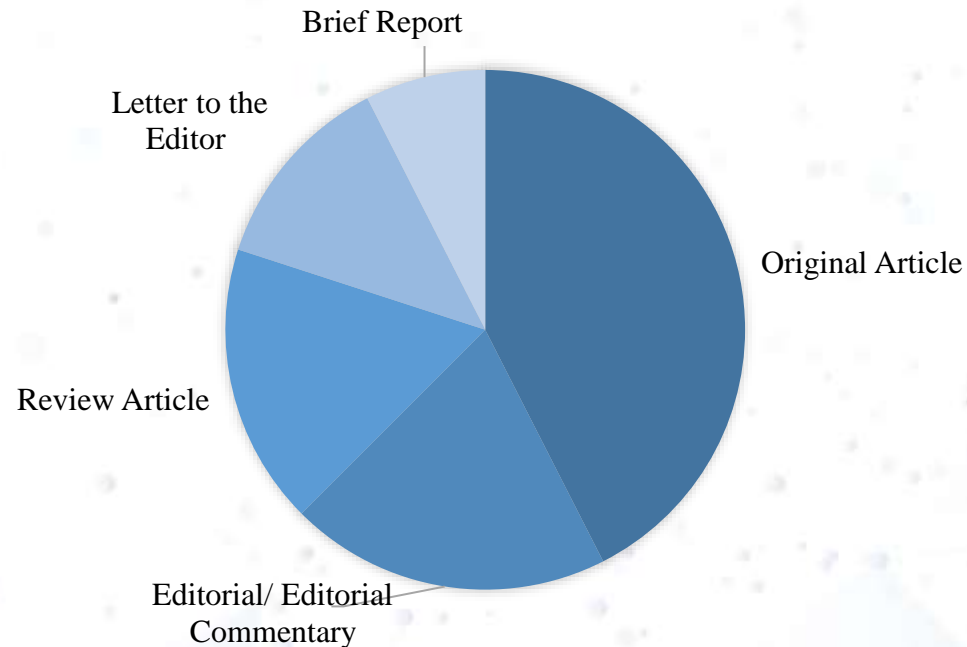

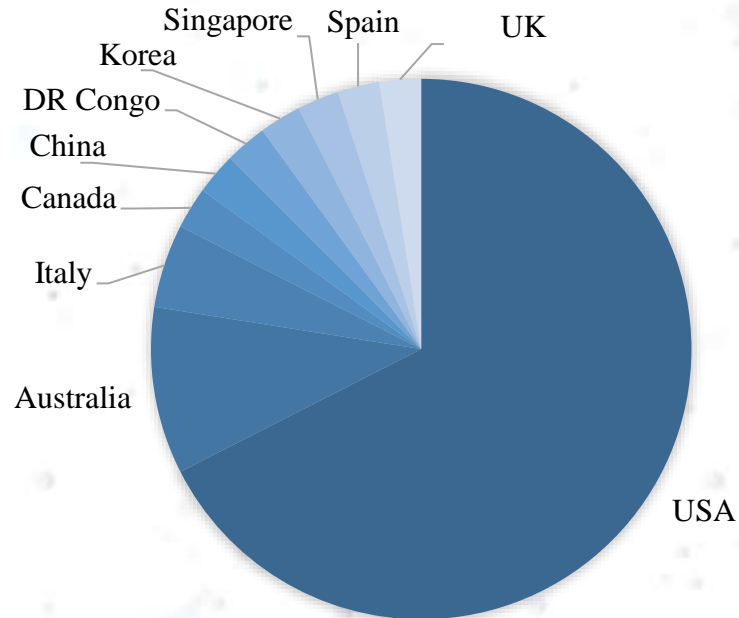

### 3. Diverse Types of Articles Published in 2020



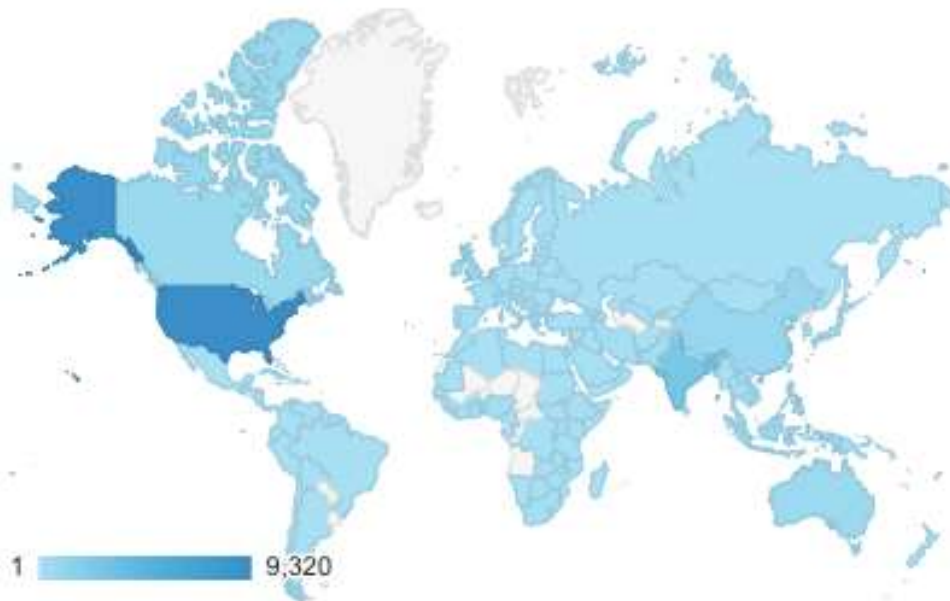
