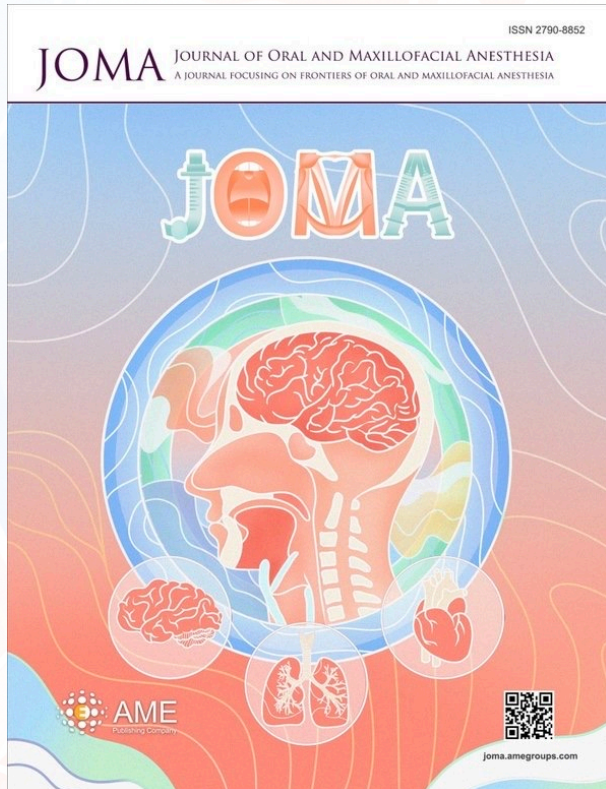

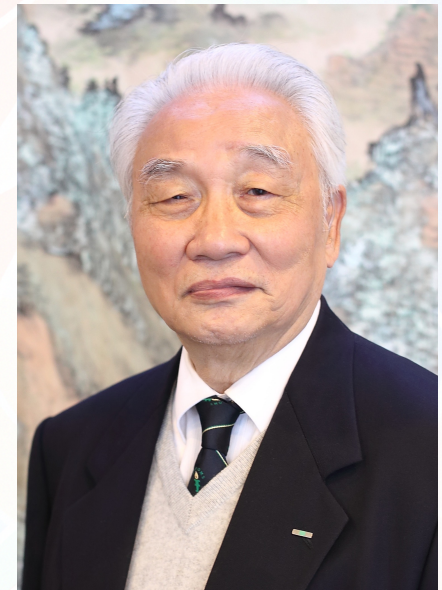
## 2.1 Honorary Editors-in-Chief

### In memoriam: Professor Wei-liu Qiu

We are extremely saddened by the passing of Prof. Wei-liu Qiu on May 24, 2024 at the age of 92. Hailed as "the father of plastic surgery in China", Prof. Wei-liu Qiu was one of the founders and pioneers of oral and maxillofacial surgery in China, and the first member of the Chinese Academy of Engineering in the field of stomatology.

With a long-time dream of publishing an English journal of oral and maxillofacial surgery, Prof. Wei-liu Qiu realized this dream in May 2019 by supporting the launch and being the Honorary Editor-in-Chief of the *Frontiers of Oral and Maxillofacial Medicine (FOMM)*, the official publication of Shanghai Ninth People's Hospital, Shanghai Jiao Tong University School of Medicine. In March 2022, we have the pleasure to work with Prof. Hong Jiang, Prof. Ming Xia and Prof. Wei-liu Qiu to launch Journal of Oral and Maxillofacial Anesthesia (JOMA) with Prof. Qiu being the Honorary Editor-in-Chief.

We will continue to follow the guidance that Prof. Qiu had given to FOMM and JOMA.

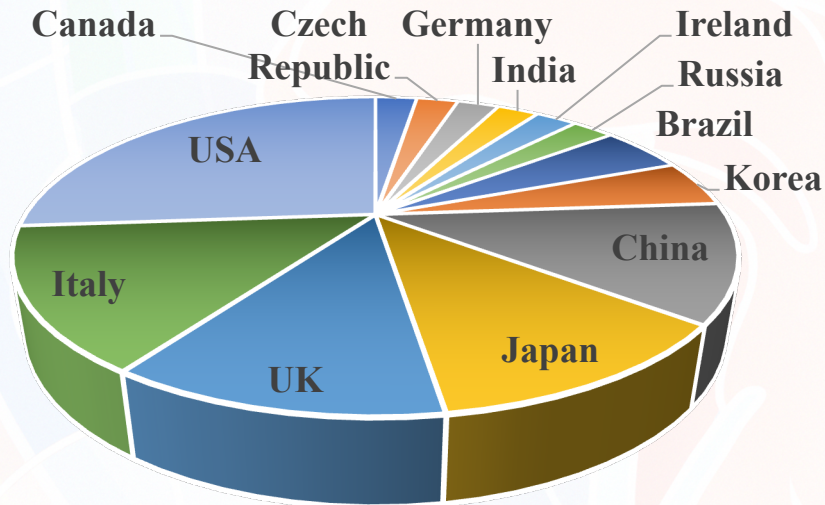

#### Geographic Distribution of Current Editorial Board Members



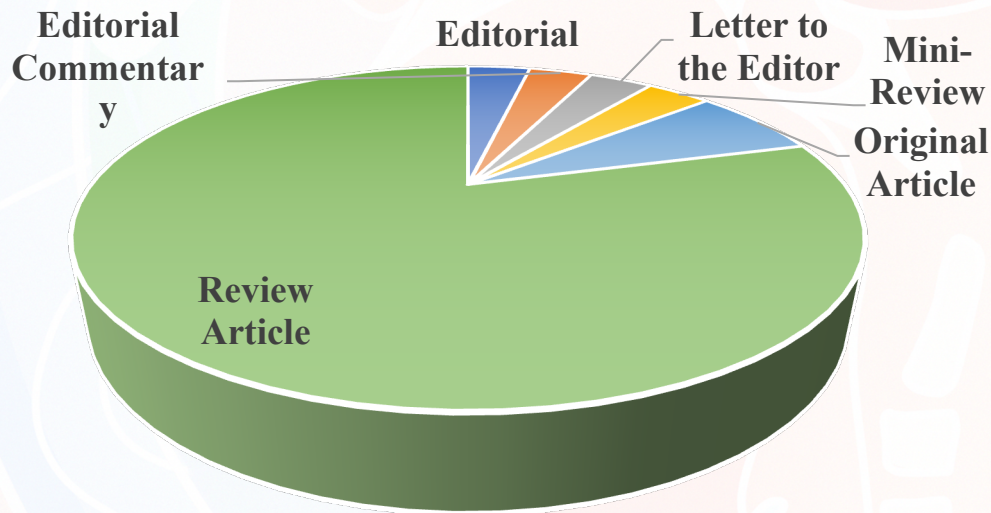

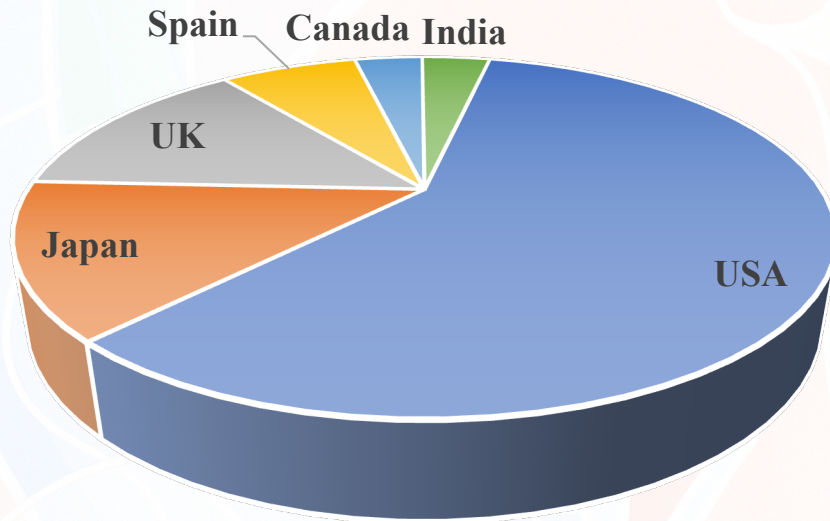

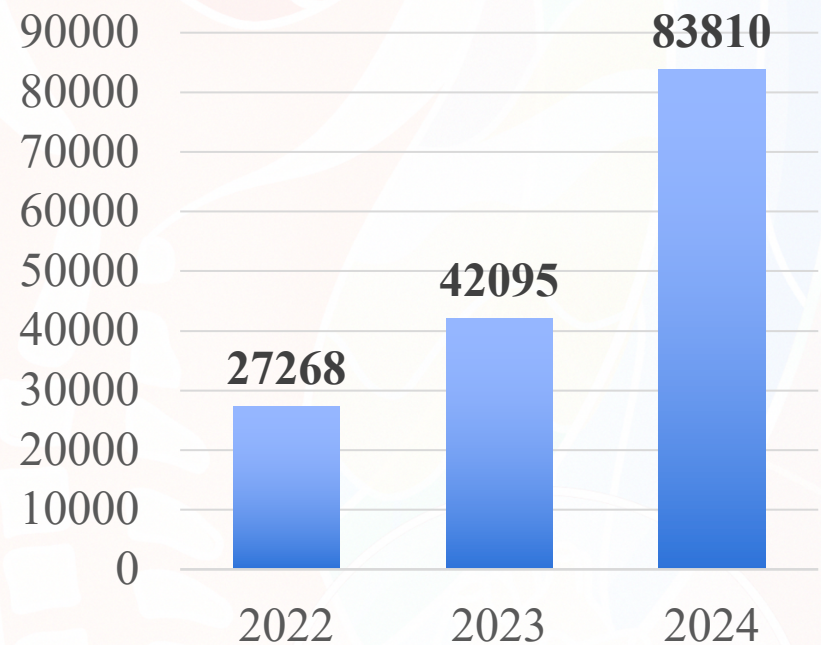
