

All together 102 members from 19 countries.



4. Diverse Types of Articles Published in 2023




Since launched in May 2017, SHC has published a total of **397** articles. **33** were published in 2023 with diverse article types.

Corresponding authors of **33** articles in 2023 came from **10** countries with mostly from **USA, Italy, Japan, UK, and China.**



6. Page Views of the Website (2023)




In 2023, SHC received 125,274 pageviews in total, with the monthly pageviews shown above.






10. Annual Report of Shanghai Chest Hospital
