




3. Number of Published Articles (results by year)

4. Diverse Types of Articles Published in 2021



5. International Diversity of Corresponding Authors in 2021




Corresponding authors of **40 articles** in 2021 came from **12 countries**, with a majority **from USA, China and Spain**.




