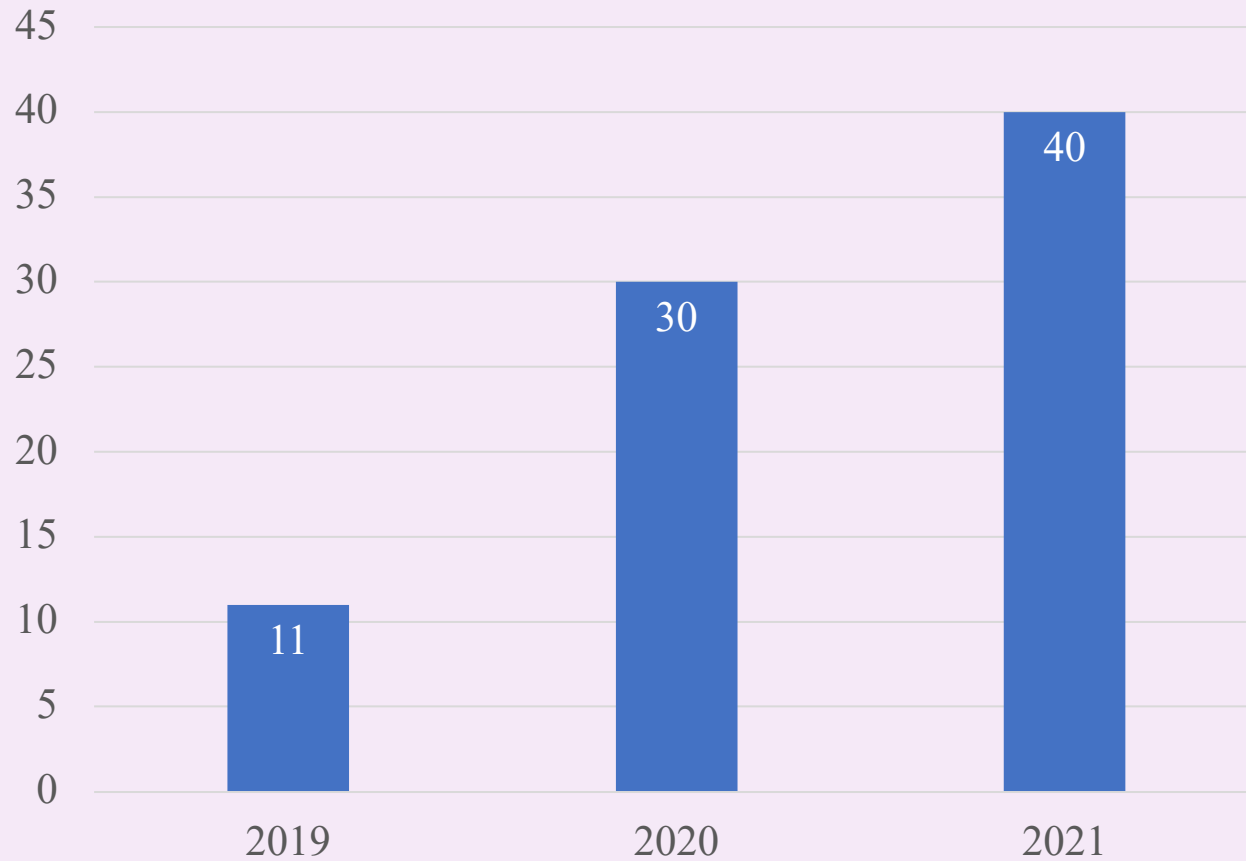

### 3. Number of Published Articles (results by year)

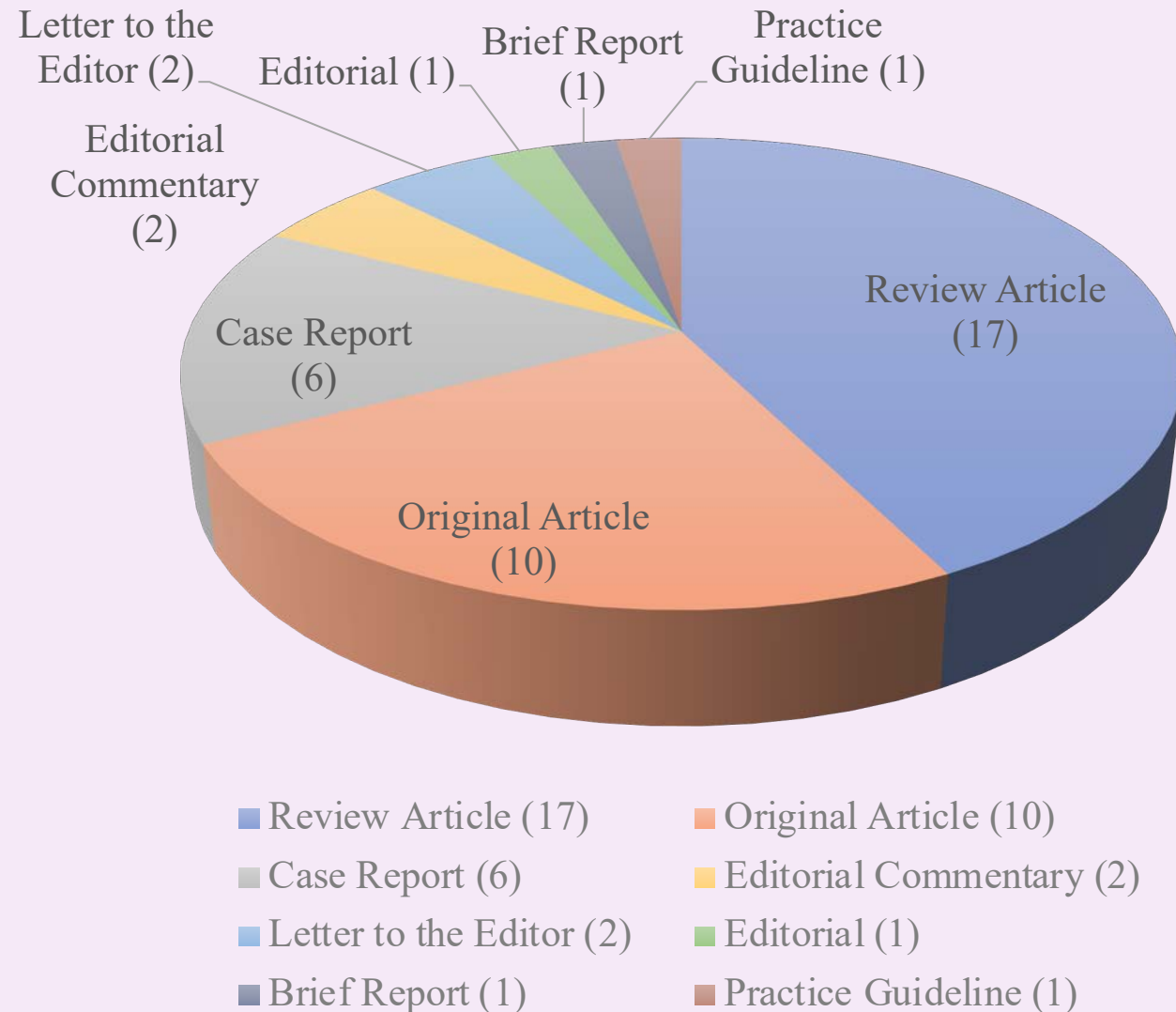

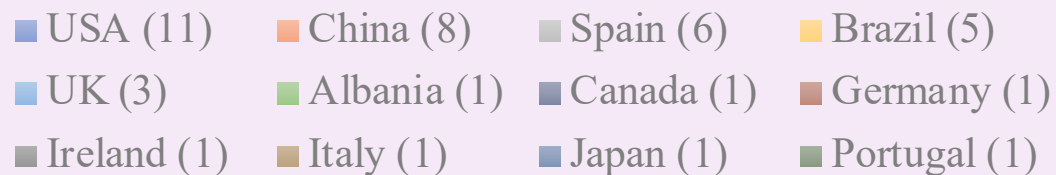
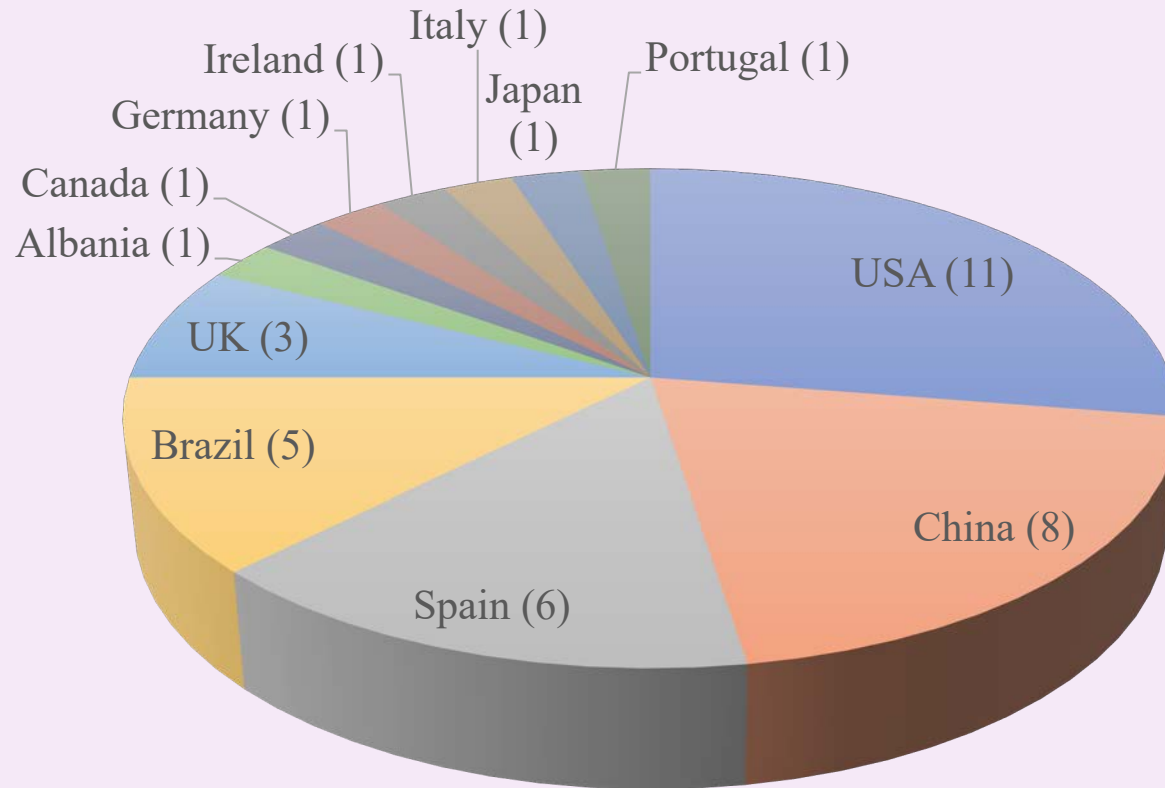
## 4. Diverse Types of Articles Published in 2021



In 2021, FOMM published **40 articles**, including 27 Review Article/Original Article.



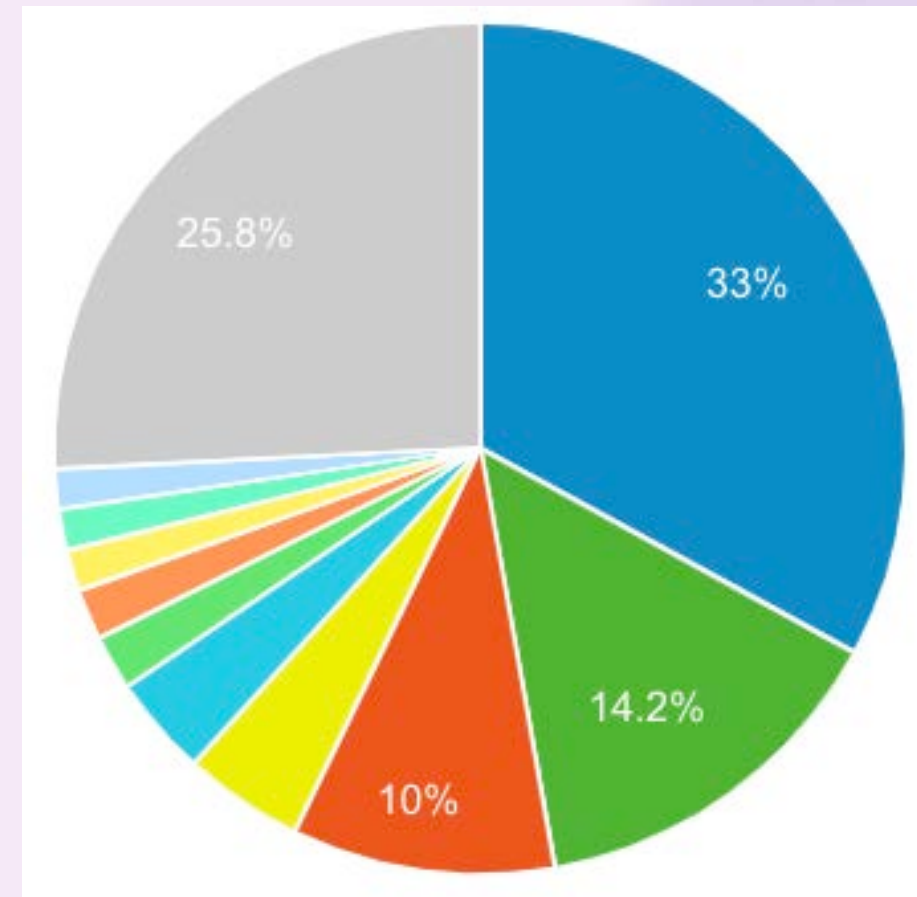
## 5. International Diversity of Corresponding Authors in 2021

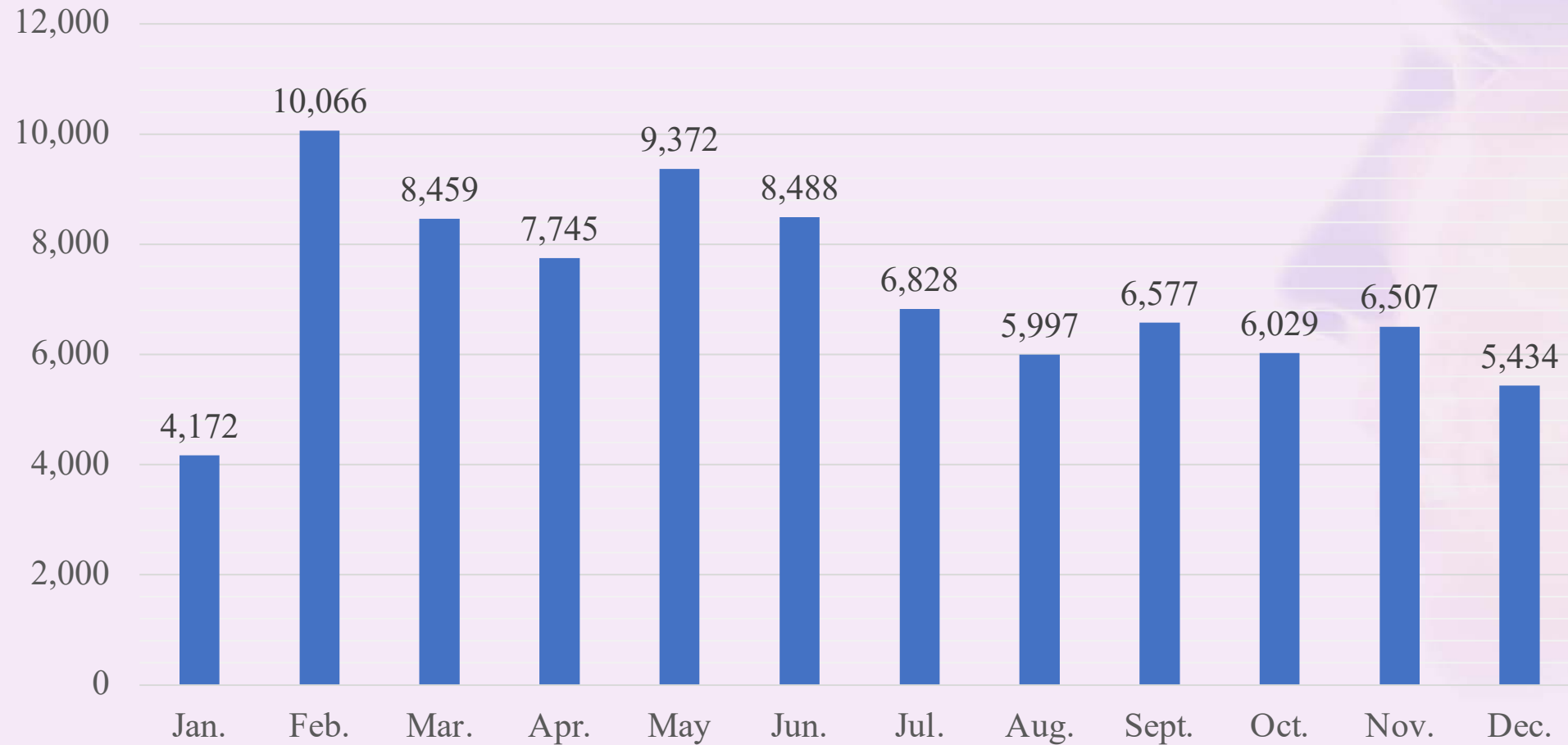


All together there are **18,386** visitors in 2021. Readers were from diverse countries, with a majority from USA, followed by China, India, and UK.

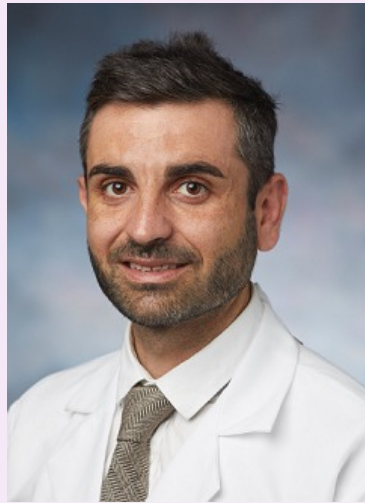
