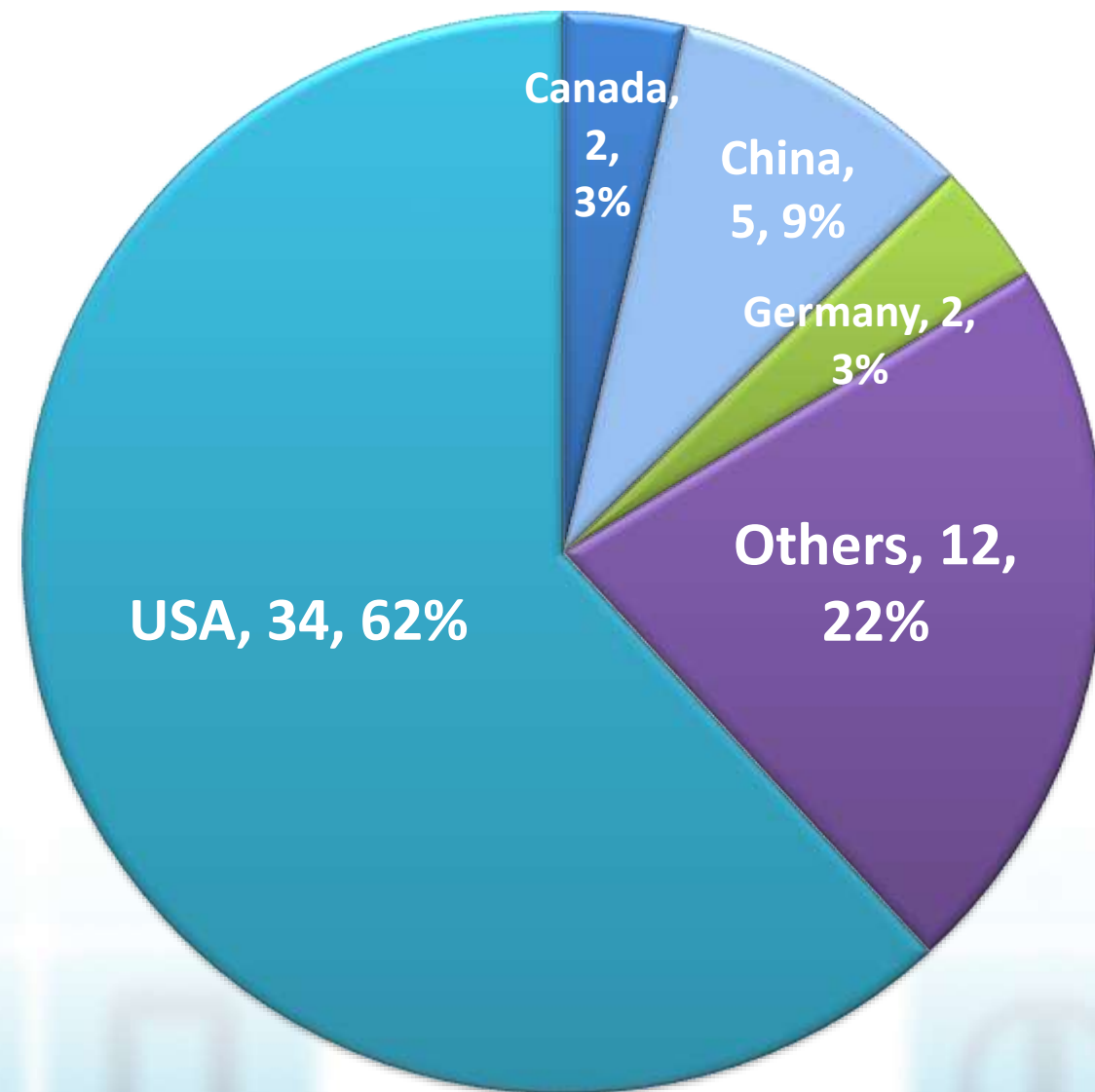

## 3. Distribution of Editorial Board Members

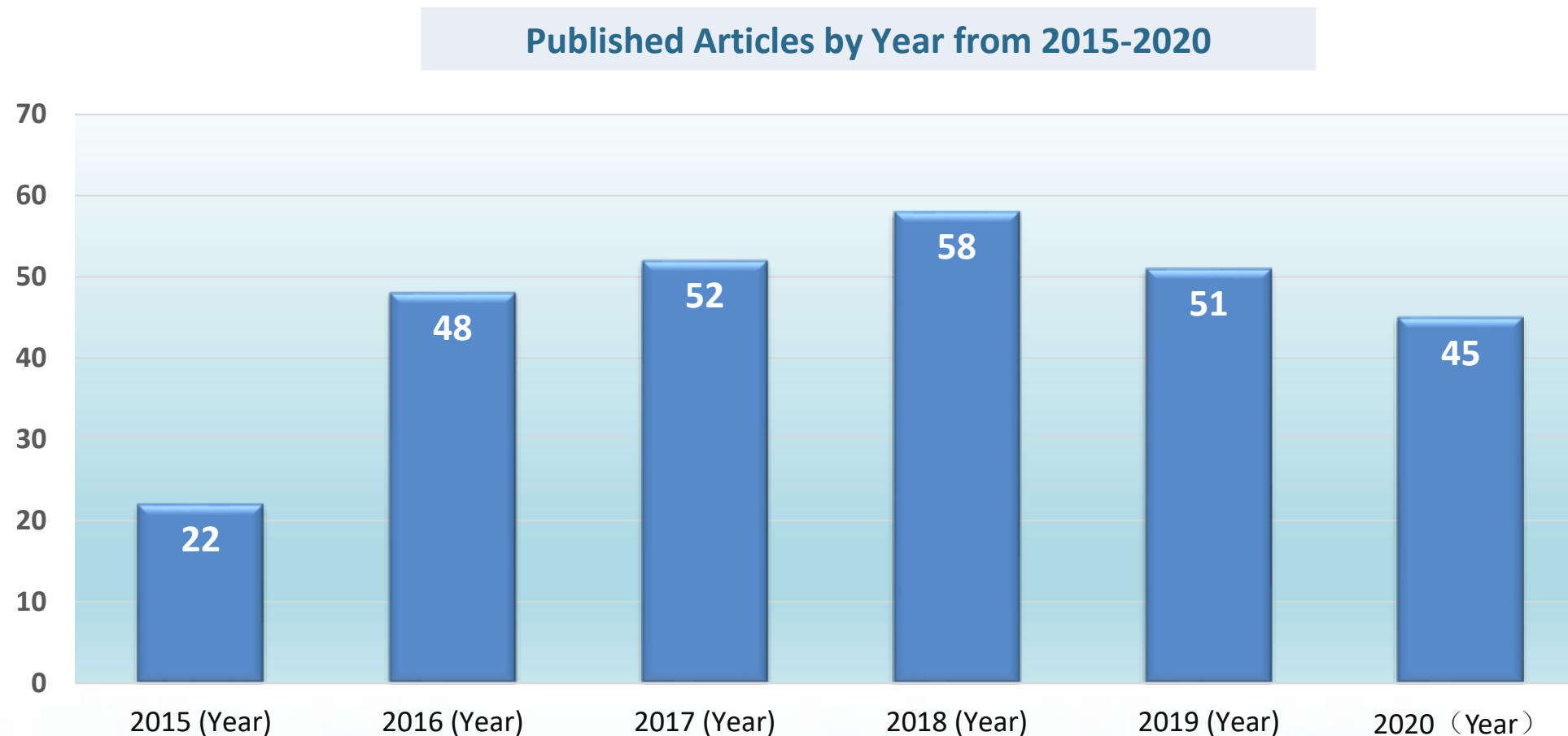


Altogether **55** members from **16** countries:

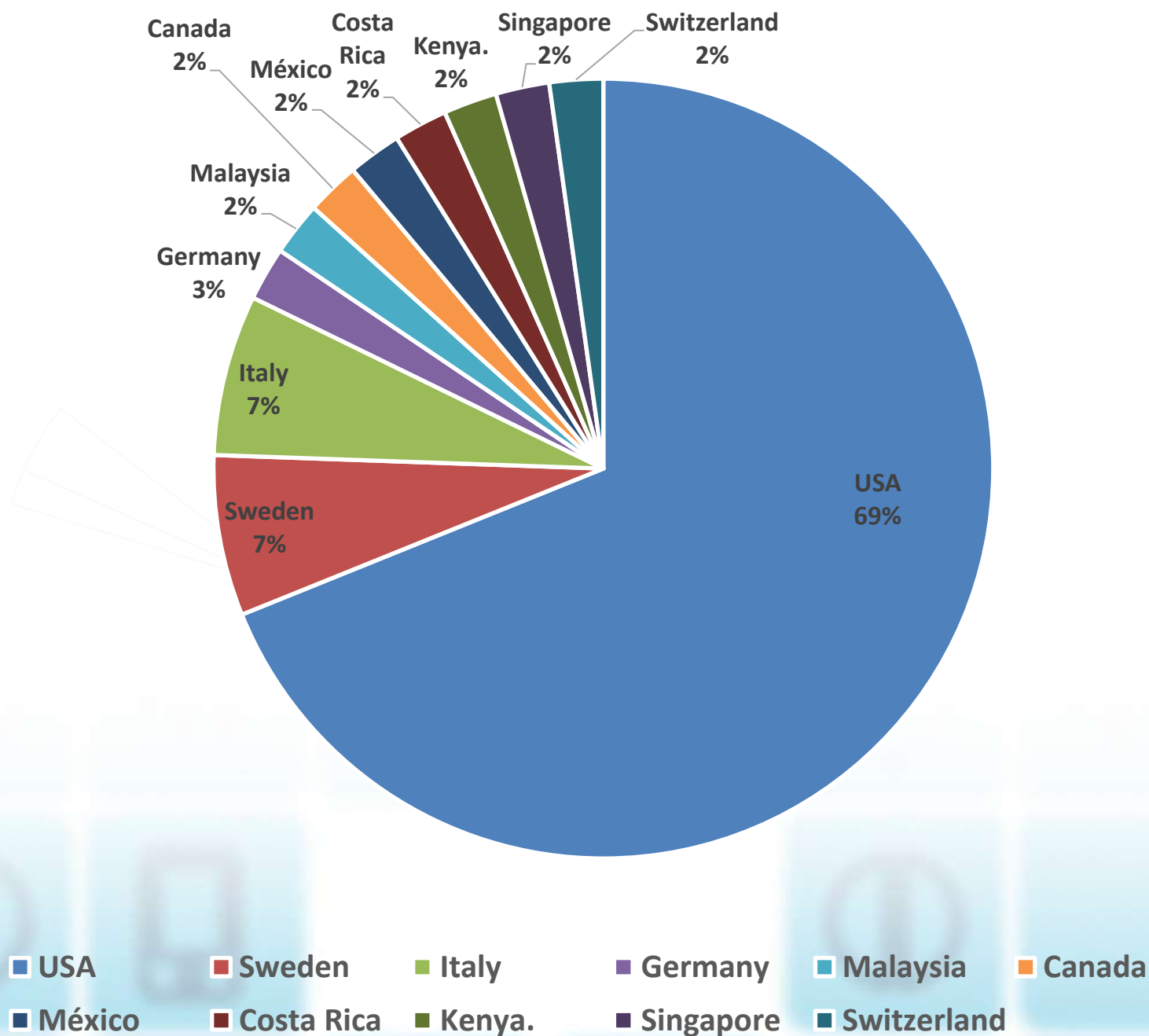

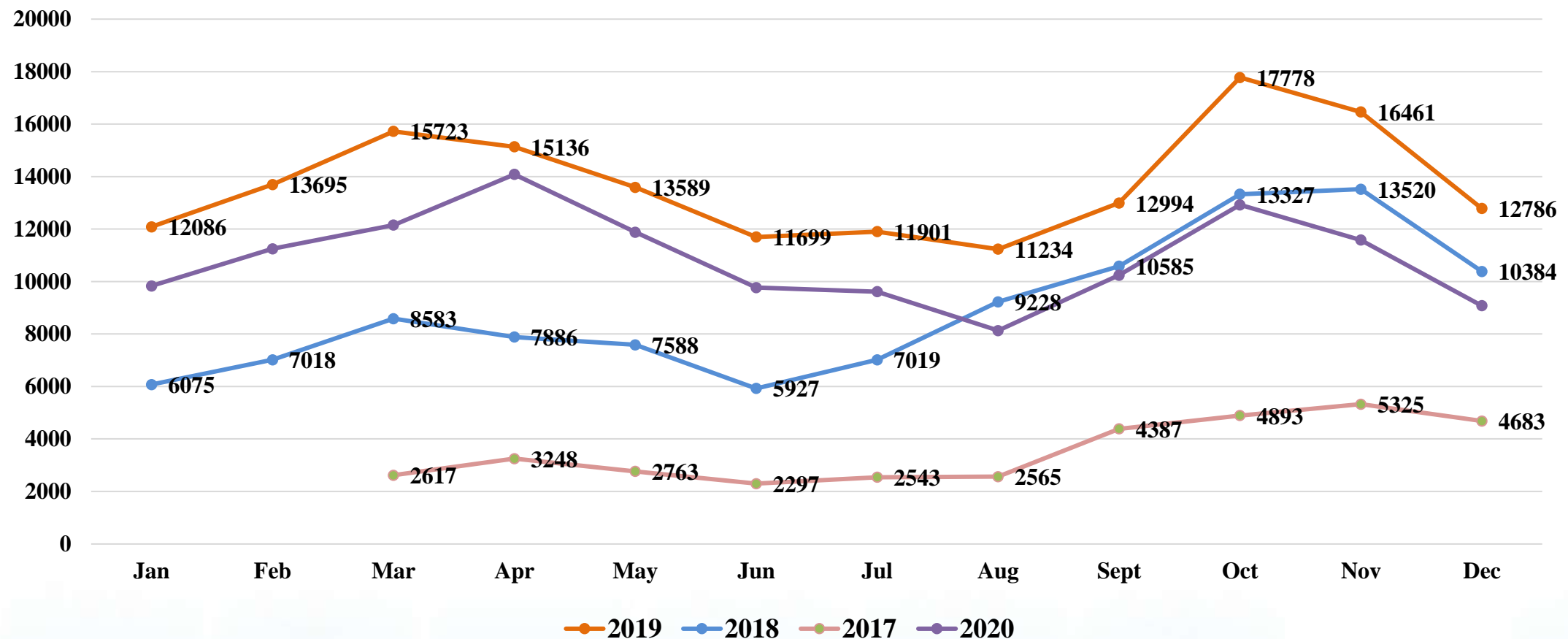
## 6. Diversity of Corresponding Authors in 2020



- **45** corresponding authors of articles published in 2020 come from 11 countries, which fully represents the international diversity in mHealth.

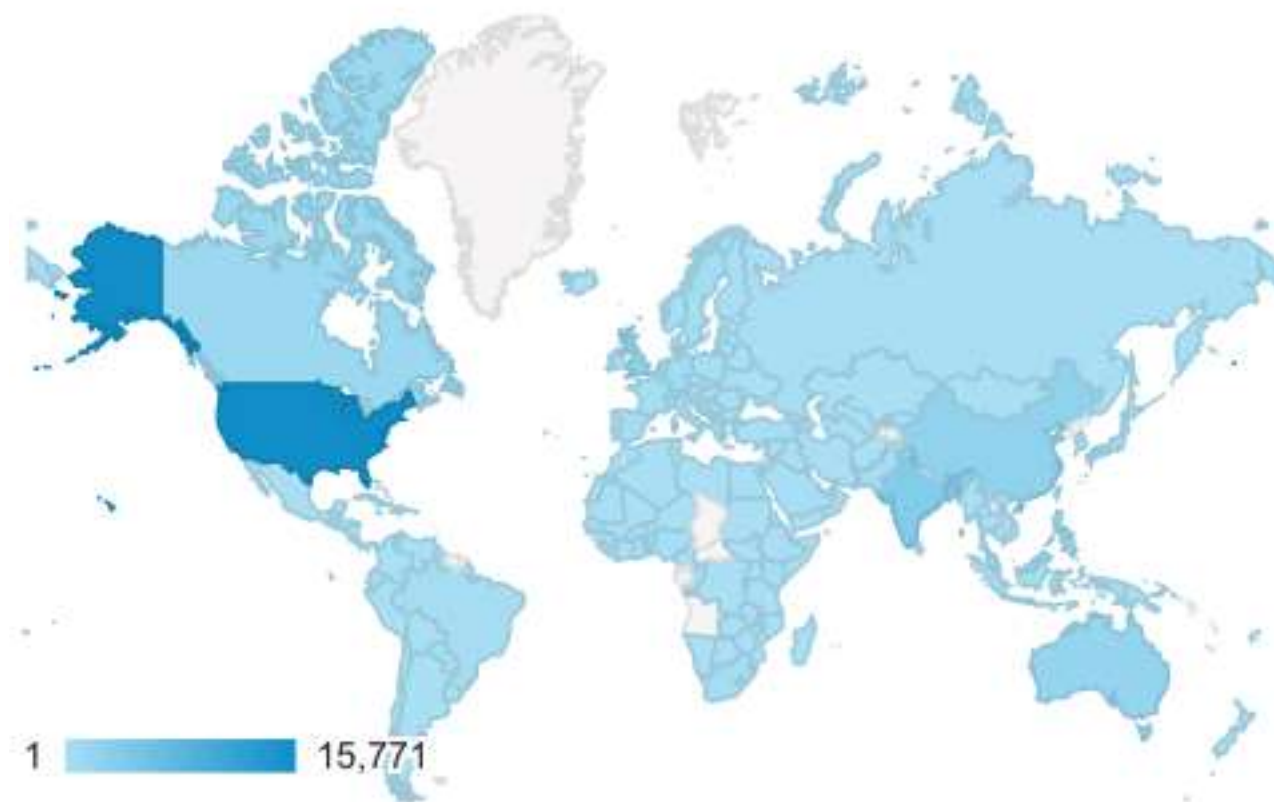


## 7. Comparison of Monthly Retrievals from PubMed from 2017 to 2020
