



Altogether 55 members from 16 countries:


- > 1 Editor-in-Chief

From March 10, 2015 to December 31, 2020, *mHealth* has published **276** articles in total.






5. Diversity of Articles Published in 2020

7. Comparison of Monthly Retrievals from PubMed from 2017 to 2020




- *mHealth* was indexed in PubMed in March 2017. The graph shows the comparison of monthly retrievals from PubMed from 2017 to 2020.
