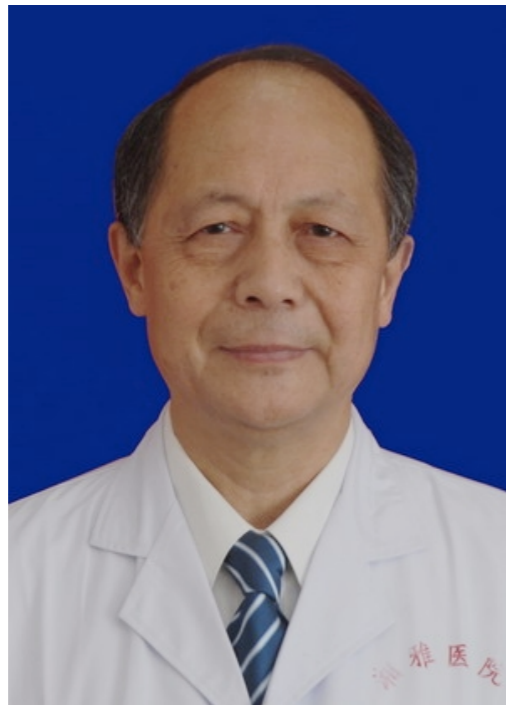

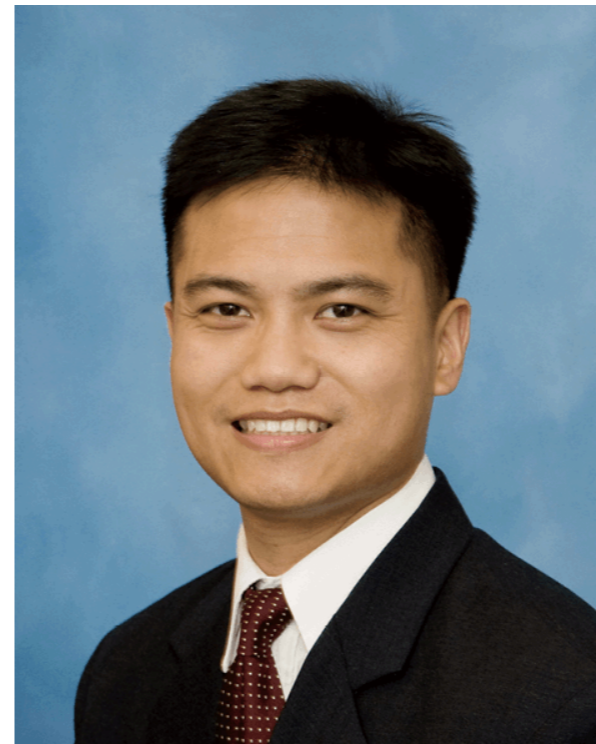

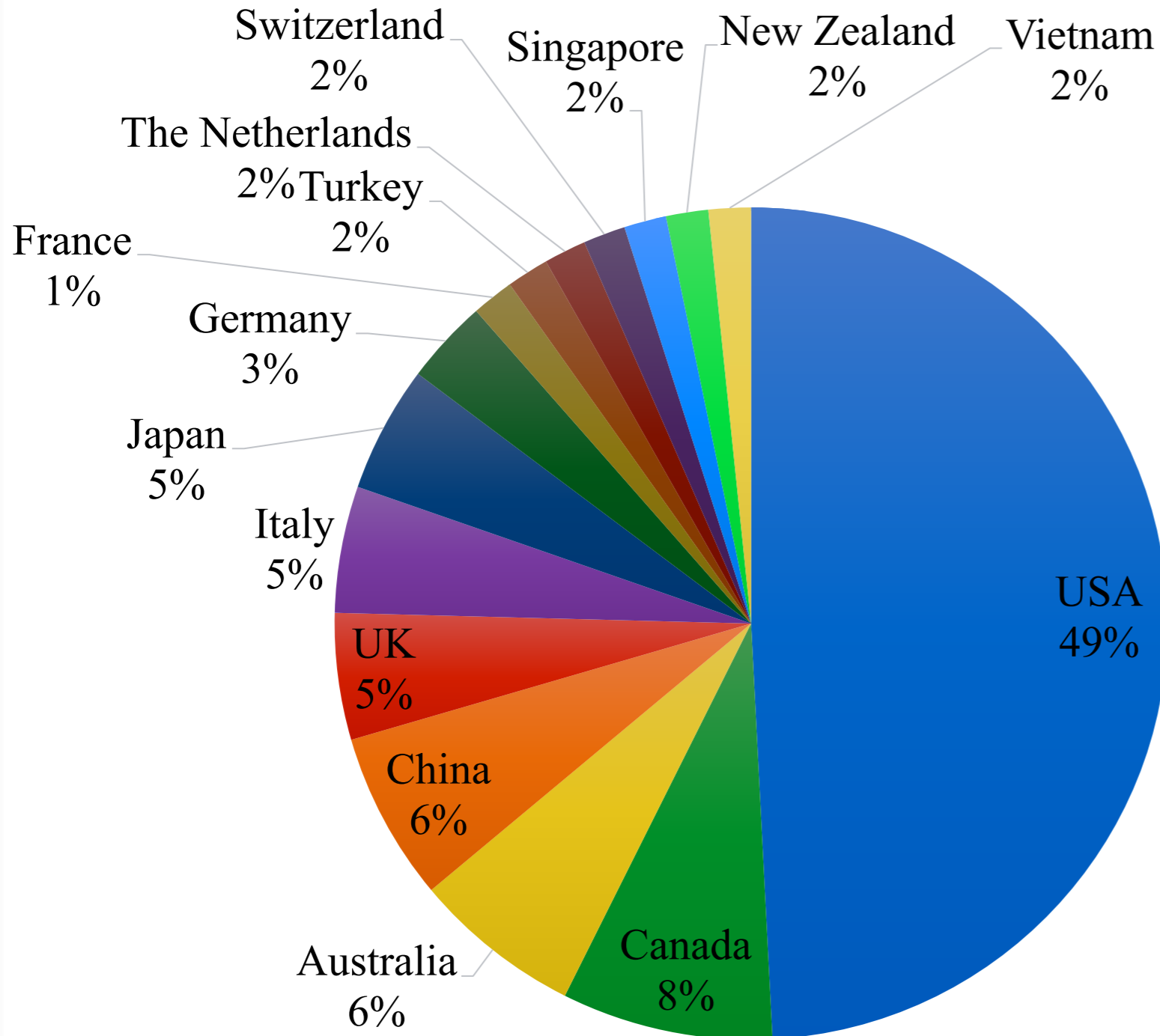

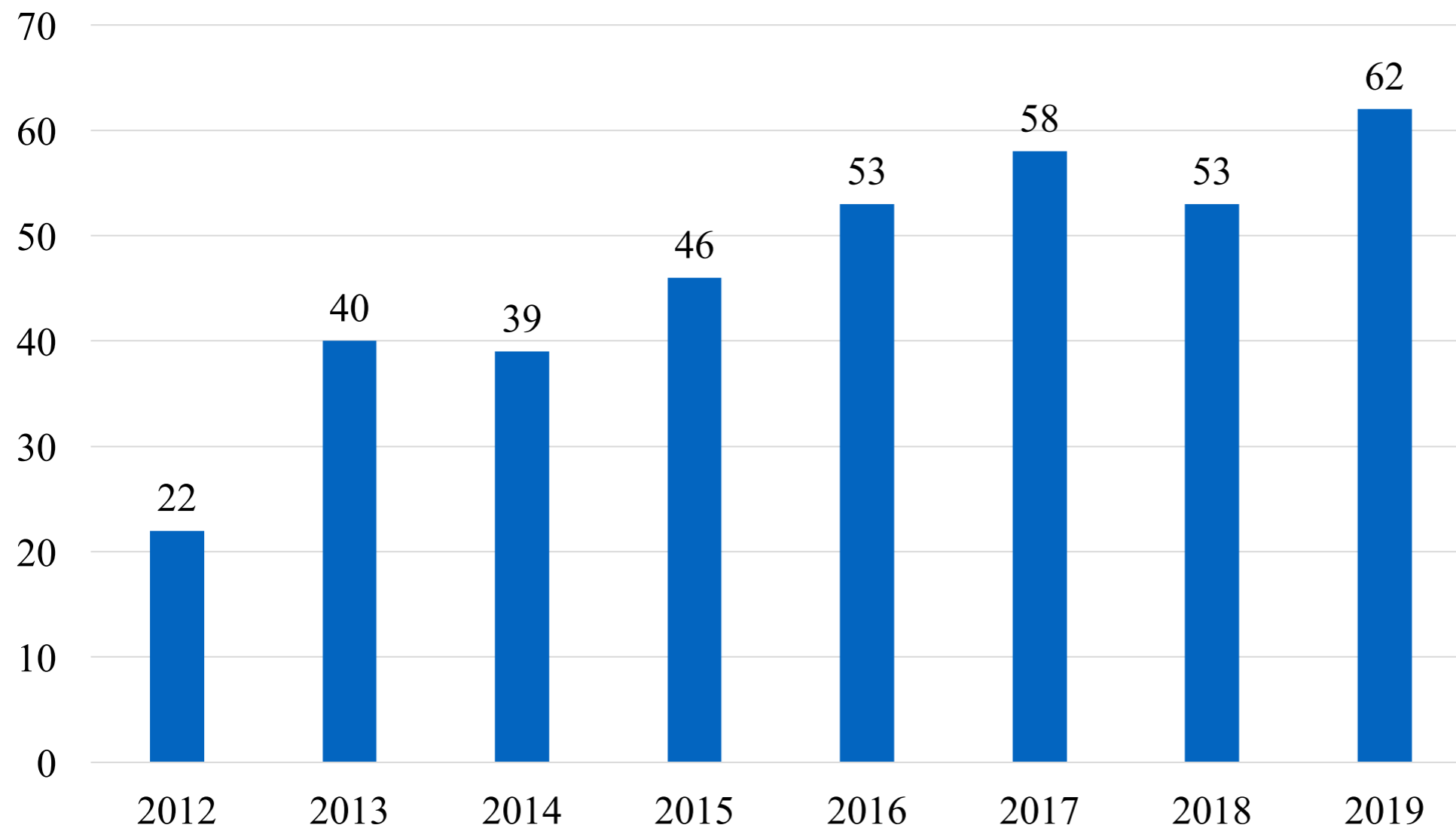
5. Distribution of Editorial Board Members

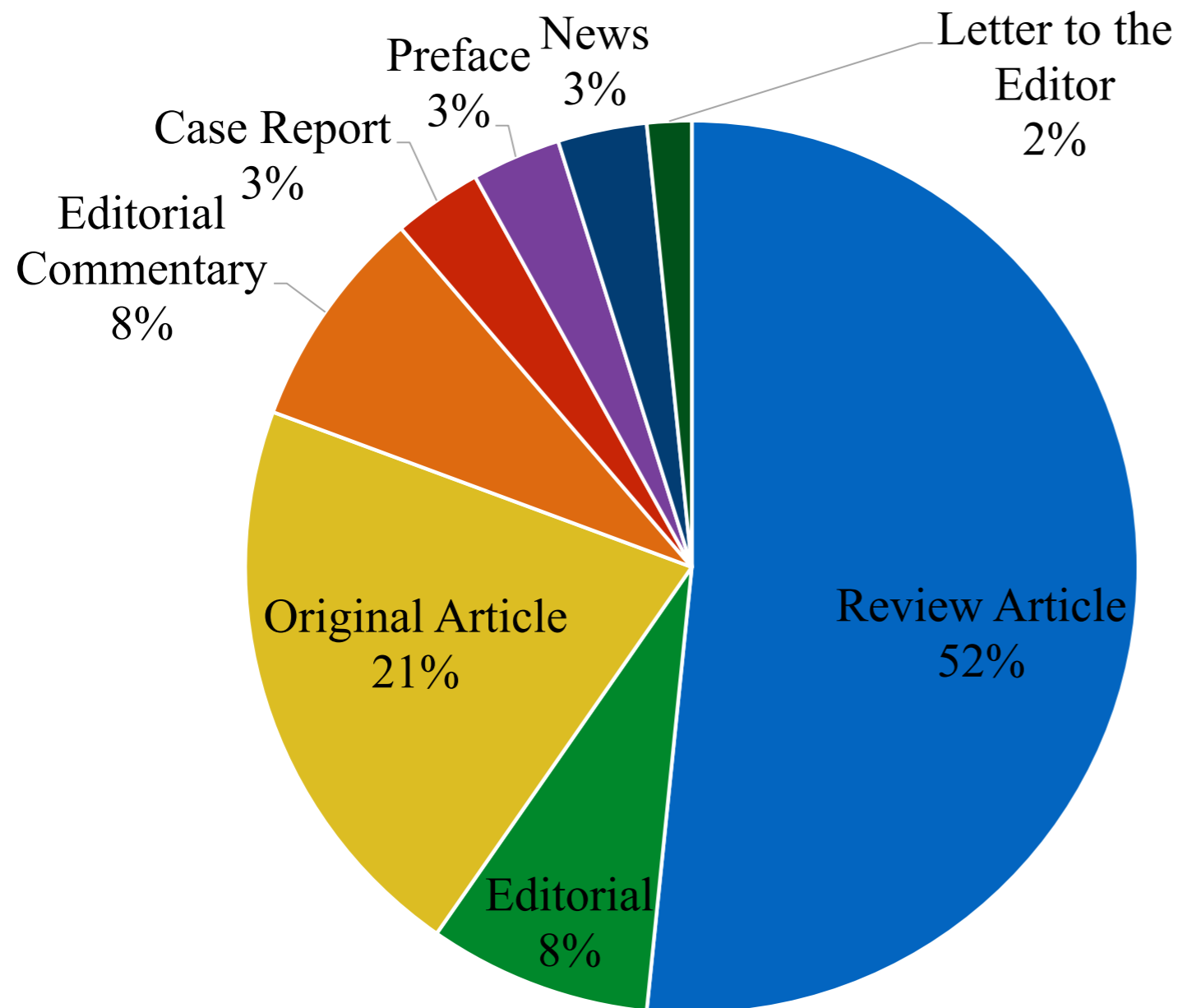

6. Number of Published Articles (results by year)



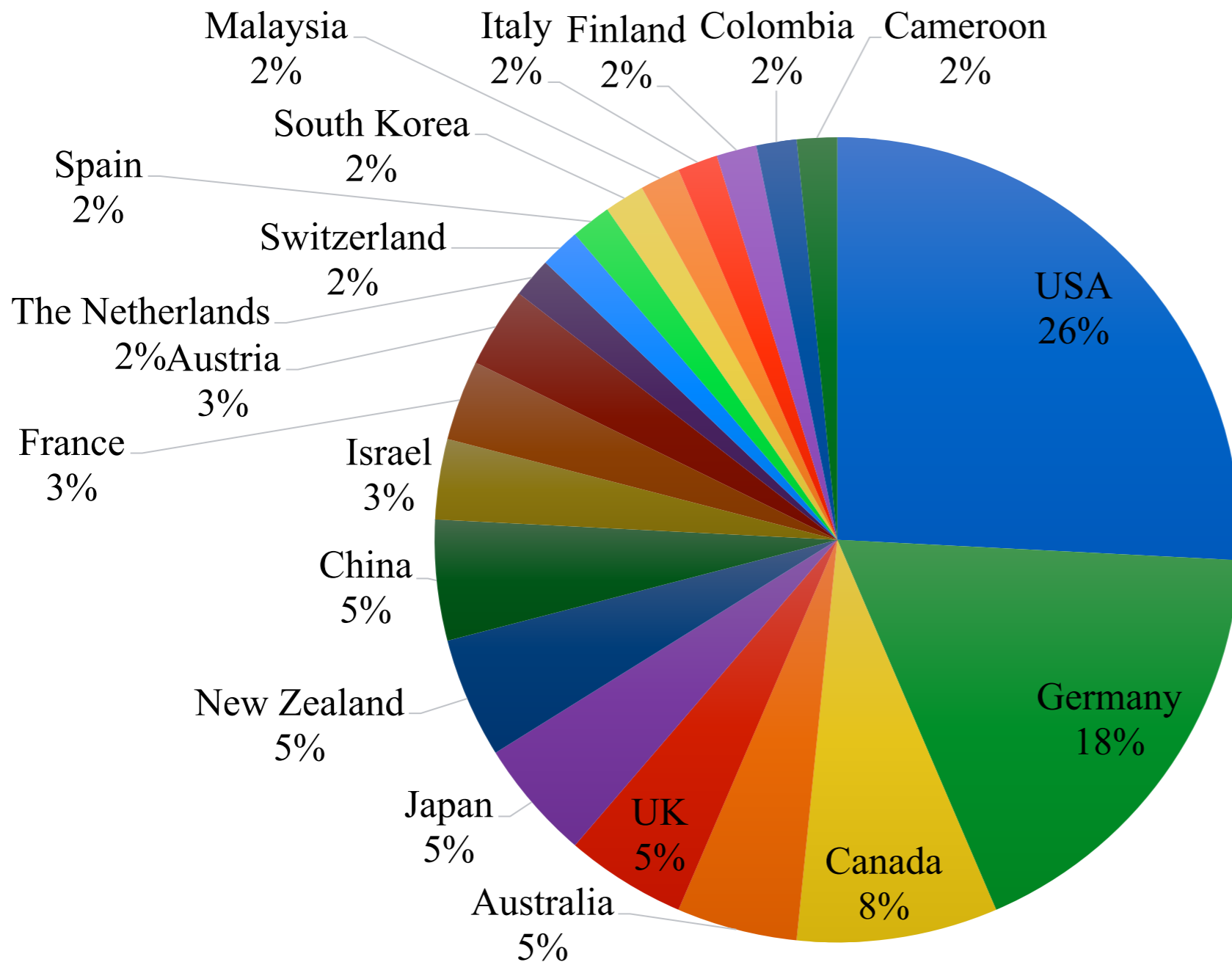
In 2019, **62** articles have been published in TP

7. Diverse Types of Article Published in 2019



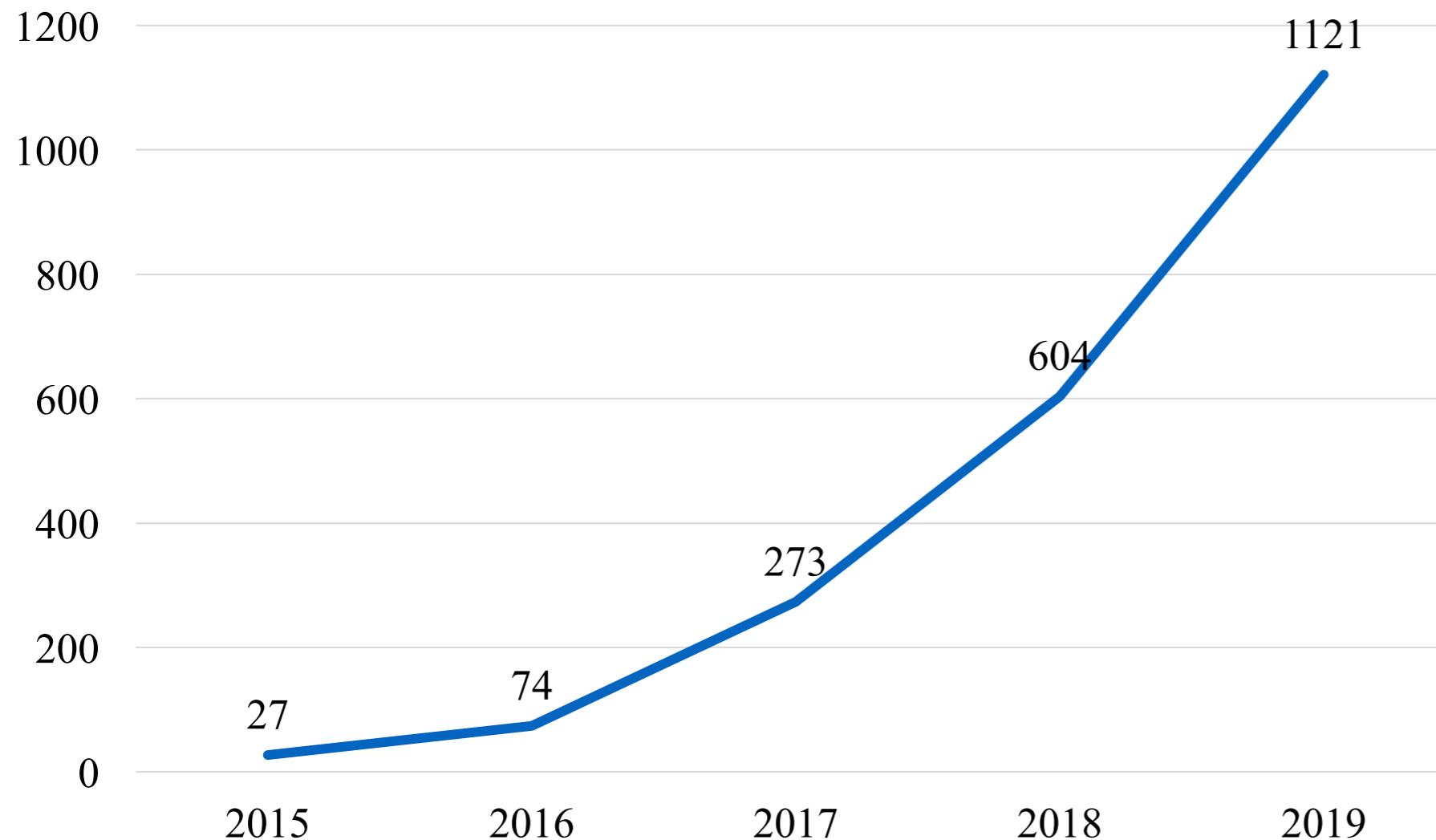
Among the 62 articles published in 2019, there are **45** review articles and **original** articles.

9. Citations in 2019 (results by year)

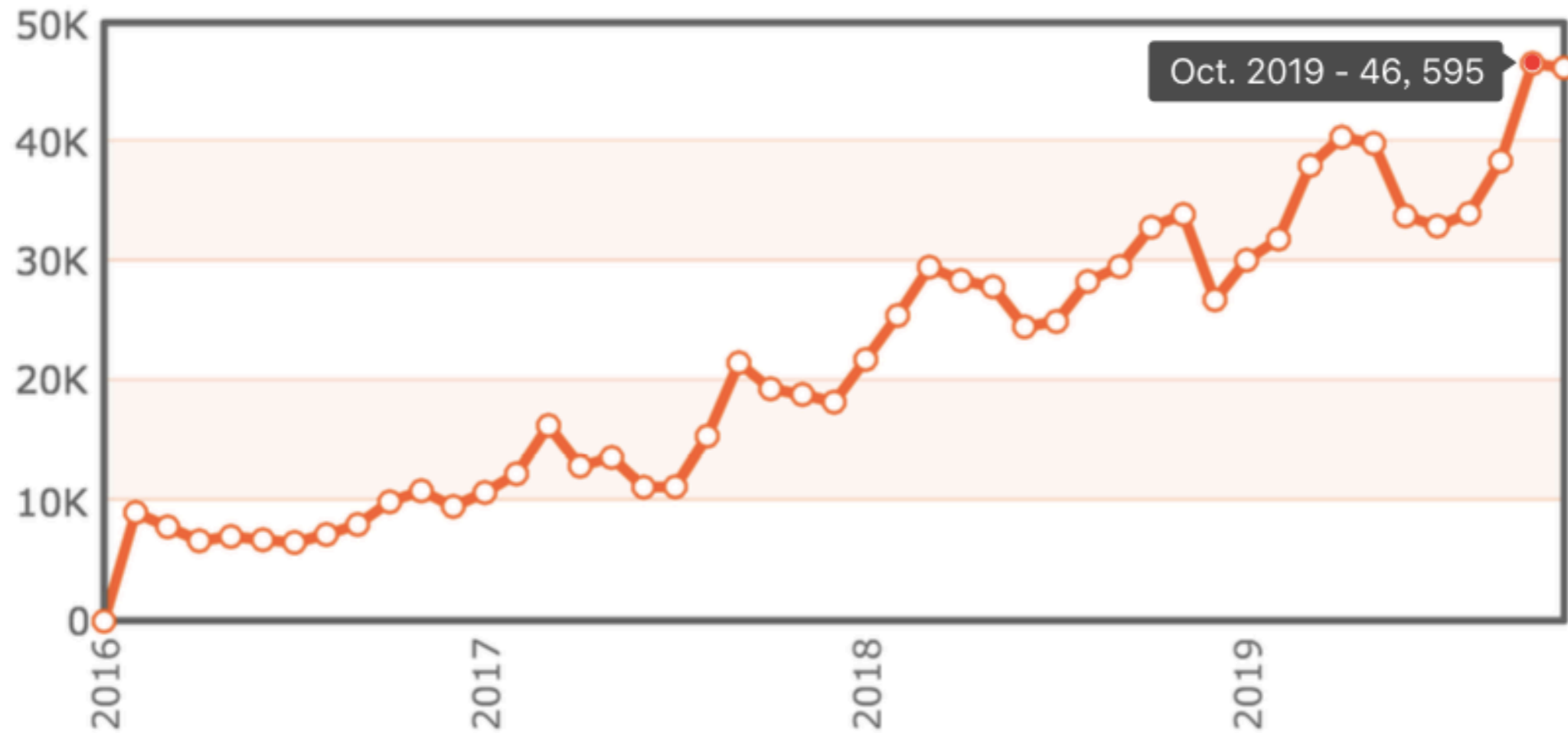


Since TP was launched, TP articles have been cited **1,121** times by articles indexed in Web of Science Core Collection.

10. Monthly Retrievals in PubMed in 2019

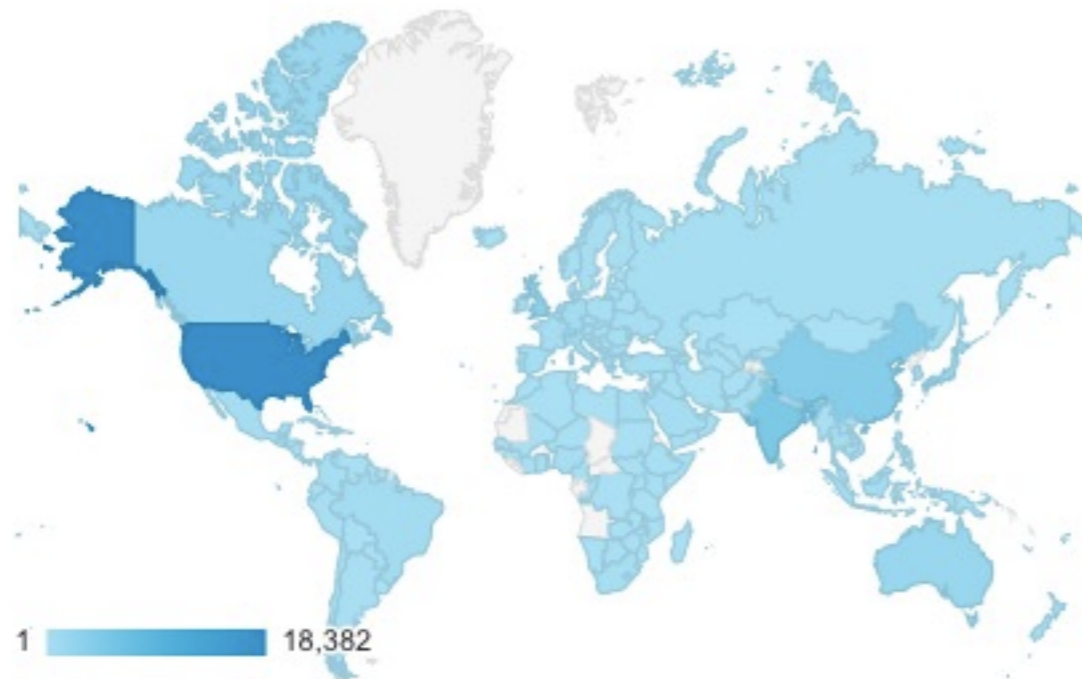
Retrieval: Total

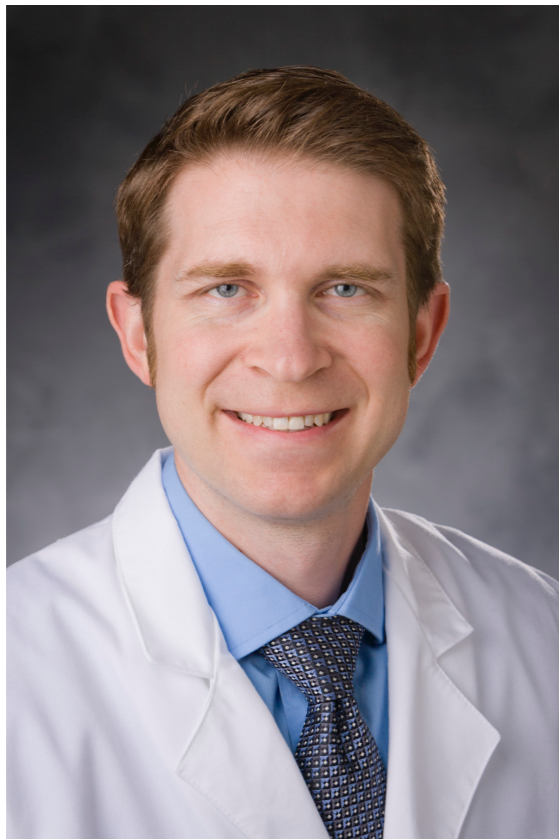
